<u>Weather Discussion:</u> An upper level low off the Washington coast will drop into the region tonight and move out of the region by Wednesday night. This will bring several changes to the fire area. There will be an additional 10-12 degrees cool down with temperatures mainly in the 80s. Winds will flow down through the Okanogan valley Monday night through Tuesday. Expect northwest-northeast winds with gusts 20-30 mph for most of the day Tuesday. The low will also bring a chance of precipitation early Tuesday morning and again Tuesday afternoon. There will also be a chance of thunderstorms late in the day. Temperatures will moderate Wednesday and Thursday, but will remain below normal. Another storm system on Friday will start the process over again with cooler temperatures and the chance for showers.

## **FIRE BEHAVIOR**

## **GENERAL:**

- Cooler temps, dry fuels, and windy conditions with potential for gusty and erratic winds near any afternoon thunderstorms: Any precipitation will temporally raise 1-hour time lag fuels moistures, but winds and dry periods will quicky contribute to 1-hour fuels availability to carry fire. Suppression efforts have been very successful but continued slight potential for isolated areas of smoldering heat near fire lines to flare up with potential to spot across lines still exists. Fire behavior potential continues to be elevated. Any spot fire that gets established in the timber litter fuels will be difficult to control with forecasted northerly winds and if a spot fire gets established in the lighter grass and sage brush fuels, potential for significant spread exists.
- Fuels consist mixed conifer and pine with grass and brush. Logging slash is in scattered locations. There are some areas of regeneration from past timber harvest and 5 to 10-year-old fire scar regen with grass and brush understory. Much of the lower elevations are covered with grass and sagebrush with timbered stringers in the deep draws.
- Most spotting will be short range and with wind gusts, spotting near 0.2 mile possible.
- Probability of Ignition will be near 70% unshaded and 40% shaded during the warmest part of the day. ERCs' for Kramer yesterday are just below the 90<sup>th</sup> percentile

## SPECIFIC:

**DIV A/Z/W/P:** Expect smoldering and limited creeping fire on the edge of green islands in the area north of Mount Whitmore lookout.

**DIV C:** Continue to watch for heat in areas of dirty burn and retardant covered fuels near fire lines. Potential for spots across lines.

**DIV F:** Areas of dirty burn and retardant covered fuels near fire lines will continue to clean up with potential to spot. Afternoon winds will be pushing drift smoke across road south of DP 120.

**DIV L:** Watch for flare ups with potential for spots in any areas of dirty burns adjacent to fire lines.

**DIV M:** Continue to monitor for heat near fire lines.

**Initial Attack:** In the event we respond to a new start, any new start in the area with forecasted winds will have potential rapid rates of spread. Light fuels are very wind sensitive and any gusty and erratic winds associated with thunderstorms can significantly impact fire by direction changes or cause acceleration.

AIR OPERATIONS: Watch for turbulence in the complex terrain with forecasted winds and weather.

## **SAFETY**

- Heads up for winds today and chance of afternoon thunderstorms with gusty and erratic winds with lightning.
- Winds may cause fire weakened trees and snags to fall.
- 1000-hour fuel moistures are at 7% so live trees with damage trunks can catch fire and burn through becoming overhead hazards.

# **Human Resource Message**

<u>Communication</u>: occurs up, down, and across functions and it is hard to communicate too much. Whenever you have a message to communicate make sure the message is true and correct, well-reasoned, and substantiated by solid logic that is specific, consistent, clear, and accurate.

Communication is not about you it is about meeting needs, understanding concerns, and adding value to the conversation. Following are some ways to better communication:

- 1. Use "I" statements: this keeps the conversation clean.
- 2. Ask questions: questions involve the other person.
- 3. Deal with issues right away: resolve now...don't let emotions build
- 4. Admit to feelings: if feelings are getting in the way, say something like, "I'm feeling too overwhelmed right now to deal with this well, let me get back to you in a little while."
- 5. Sidestep blame: treat the "mistake" as just that, something that didn't work and then seek a resolution.
- 6. Use a neutral tone: keep sarcasm, innuendo and blame out of your voice.
- 7. Focus on the outcome: "The reason I'm bringing this up is I want to solve it, so we all feel better."
- 8. Don't focus on mistakes: focus on what needs to happen.
- 9. Turn complaints into requests: when someone starts telling you everything that is wrong, ask the person to reframe the complaints into requests.



## **How to Download Maps in Avenza**

If you're cell signal is poor you may need to connect to a wifi to download maps. However sometimes being connected to a wifi can slow map downloads. You'll just have to find out what works best.


Method 1: From a browser - If you have a good cell or wifi signal

- 1. Tap on the desired map link and wait for the preview. *If it fails to load, use method 2 instead*
- 2. Tap the 'send to' icon (square with up arrow)
- 3. Choose the Avenza app

Method 2: From Avenza direct – if you don't have a good cell or wifi signal



- 1. Tap and hold on the desired map link, then choose 'copy' to copy the direct URL to the map
- 2. Launch the Avenza app
- 3. When not in any map... Tap the + (plus) icon at the top of the screen
- 4. Choose the load from URL option (last choice)
- 5. Paste the direct URL to the map
- 6. Tap 'Done'; the map will begin downloading








#### How to Send Map Updates to the Situation Unit

## WHITMORE FIRE COVID-19 MITIGATIONS

Supervisors are required to go over this list each morning with assigned resources- report any positive symptoms to medical unit.

Observe 6ft Distancing whenever possible.

Observe "Module as One" practices – only close contact with crew (engine, handcrew, etc.) that you live and work with all summer. Observe distancing and masking around everyone else. Do not co-mingle with other crews or "modules" in camp or on the line.

Send crew representatives to pick up meals - masks must be worn in food lines.

No entry to ICP building except Incident Management Team members

Wash hands frequently and disinfect high-traffic areas on a regular basis.

Limit close contact between firefighters and the public to prevent exposure and spread.

# EMERGENCY PLAN INCIDENT WITHIN AN INCIDENT

## ON SCENE INCIDENT COMMANDER

In the event of an accident or medical incident of any size, your primary responsibility is to ENSURE that the victim(s) receive prompt and effective Triage, Treatment, Extrication and Transport.

- ENSURE THE MEDICAL INCIDENT REPORT IN THE INCIDENT ACTION PLAN IS BEING USED AND FOLLOWED- \*IF DETERMINED TO BE A GREEN, DO NOT DECLARE EMERGENCY TRAFFIC AND ONLY COMPLETE LINE 1-4 ON MIR\*.
- Conduct size-up of the incident nature of accident, number type of resources involved, latitude and longitude location (DD°MMM.MM format): notify incident communications center and supervisor, request assistance as needed.
- Order and coordinate medical and support response to the accident.
- Evaluate special needs (law enforcement, haz mat, etc.).
- Clear the command frequency if medical emergency, coordinate with incident communications and air attack for air medical transportation needs.
- Preserve and photograph the scene for accident investigation.
- Remain aware of surroundings and the status of the main incident (delegate personnel to monitor the main fire) to ensure safety of medical treatment personnel.
- Until relieved, supervise and manage all personnel involved at the incident scene.
