



  - Identify EMT's in your Division and write down their names and contacts info. Know where the Fireline Medic is operating. Follow the Medical Incident Report (8 Line) if there is a Medical Incident.
  - Maintain safe speed on roads in the fire area. Always use back up personnel
  - Temperatures are increasing daily. Give emphasis to maintain hydration. Use both water and electrolyte drinks.
  - Terrain is very steep in many areas. Watch for rollers. Do not work below others.
  - Use extreme caution working around snags. Mark hazard trees if you can safely.
  - Report of all injuries, regardless of severity, to your supervisor as soon as possible.
  - Maintain: Lookouts, Communications, Escape Routes and Safety Zones (LCES)
