MAP 1 Condition

Fire is predicted to reach or has reached the MAPHVRA's Affected:

- Campgrounds and trailheads
- Salt Creek and Waldo Snow-Parks
- Willamette Pass Ski Area
- Odell Lake
- Hwy 58

Actions (based on predicted fire growth):

- Closing recreation sites and trailheads around Waldo Lake
- Closing Waldo Lake Road (FS 5897 and FS 5898) including spur road accessing Waldo Lake from the north
- Coordinating with Deschutes National Forest and Klamath County
- Developing evacuation/structure protection for at Odell Lake
- Consider implementing travel restrictions on Hwy 58

MAP 2 Condition

Actions (based on predicted fire growth):

- Communicate with ODOT on implementing travel restrictions on Hwy 58
- Closing campgrounds and recreation sites along the Hwy 58 corridor

MAP 3 Condition

Fire is predicted to reach or has reached the MAPHVRA's Affected:

- Wolf Mountain Com Site

Actions (based on predicted fire growth):

- Communicating with ODOT on implementing a closure on Hwy 58
- Communicating with Union Pacific about possible impacts to the railroad
- Closing campgrounds and recreation sites along the Hwy 58 corridor
- Developing structure protection plans for Wolf Mountain com site
- Establishing communication with Homeland Security

MAP 5 Condition

- Implement structure protection plans for Hill Creek Lake area
- Coordinating with Hills Dam management personnel
- Coordinating with Oregon Department of Forestry and industrial land owners (Sierra Pacific Timber Company)

- Assessing the need for further structure protection and mitigation efforts along Aufderheide Drive
- Closing campgrounds and access around Waldo Lake

- Prepare structure protection plans for Kahanie Guard Station
- Implement mitigation measures for Constitution Old Grove
- Implement structure protection plans for values along Aufderheide Drive
