Approved dipping sites are highlighted in green. Green sites have no known resource concerns that exclude them from dipping consideration unless expressed by management at the time of the incident. **Lakes highlighted in yellow are mitigable.** Find the site in the table below, and take the mitigation action listed in order to gain approval for dipping at this location. **Under no circumstance should lakes highlighted in red be used for dipping.** Avoid dipping from Wilderness lakes when possible to avoid impacts on Wilderness Character. The preference is to dip from multiple lakes as opposed to hitting any one lake too hard. Lake levels should not be reduced greater than 1/4 of the total volume/depth. Please monitor changes in lake level with a stick in the water several feet from the shoreline with the beginning level marked.
