Comments / notes on tonight's mission and this interpretation:

Tonight's mapping used an incident provided perimeter as a base for mapping.

Growth was limited and was predominantly mapped along the fire's eastern and northeastern edge.

No perimeter growth to the south onto privately owned lands was noted.

Intense heat was mapped west of FS road 160 and south of FS trail 161.

Intense heat was also mapped on the north facing slope south of Kalana River north of FS road 8122.

Isolated heat sources were mapped along the fire's southwestern, northern and to a lesser extent southern boundary.
