Comments / notes on tonight's mission and this interpretation:

Tonight's mapping used the Event Polygon – Wildfire daily perimeter as a base for mapping.

Almost no growth was detected tonight with less than one acre of growth in the fire's northeastern corner. This area had heat concentrations high enough to be considered intense heat.

Scattered heat was mapped in the fire's eastern lobes.

Isolated heat sources were once again mapped throughout much of the fire area.
