Comments / notes on tonight's mission and this interpretation:

Tonight's mapping used the incident event polygon as a base for mapping.

The Nakia fire showed significant westward growth with all areas of perimeter growth exhibiting intense heat.

Multiple large spot fires were mapped west and northwest of the main perimeter. The fire has crossed west of the Boulder Creek drainage. Mapped fire remained north of Cresswell Heights at time of imaging.

NOTE: An isolated heat source was located 1.3 miles south of the fire just south of NE Jones Creek Road at 45° 40.236′ N 122° 18.943′ W
