Comments / notes on tonight's mission and this interpretation:

Tonight's mapping used the previous night's IR heat perimeter as a base for interpretation. Perimeter growth was mapped along the fire's western, southern and eastern edge with small areas of intense heat mapped in these areas of expansion. Last night's isolated heat northwest of the fire showed no heat tonight.

One spot fire was mapped 1/10 mile east of the fire's main perimeter on the north side of the cedar creek drainage. Much of the fire's area displayed scattered heat.
