Comments / notes on tonight's mission and this interpretation: <p><i>NOTE: this log is intended for internal incident communication only. Any unauthorized dissemination of this information or associated IR data without expressed consent of the incident management team is prohibited.</i></p> <p>Tonight's mapping used the previous IR perimeter as a base for mapping as there were no perimeter updates since the last IR available in NIFS.</p> <p>Heat perimeter growth was mapped along the fire's western, northeastern and to a lesser extent southern perimeter. In Div A, fire now extends west to, but now past the 1211 road on the north side of the river and continues along the 1200 road into the middle of section 29. Small areas of intense heat were mapped along the fire's edge in this portion of the fire.</p> <p>In Div K, growth was mapped to the east especially in the Cedar Creek drainage.</p> <p>Much of the fire's interior continues to hold scattered.</p>
