Comments / notes on tonight's mission and this interpretation: <i>NOTE: this log is intended for internal incident communication only. Any unauthorized dissemination of this information or associated IR data without expressed consent of the incident management team is prohibited.</i> Tonight's mapping used the previous IR perimeter as a base for mapping. Perimeter growth was limited tonight. Two small polygons of relatively intense heat were mapped along the fire's edge. One occurs along the fire's southern perimeter near the 1400 road. The other was located in near the Div A/K break. Neither of these are particularly intense heat bur represent the hottest portions of the fire tonight. Large pockets of scattered heat remain along much of the fire's perimeter as well as in the interior.
