.DISCUSSION...Cooler, more humid, unsettled weather will remain over the site through Monday night. Numerous showers are expected through this evening, then again on Saturday afternoon, along with the possibility of an isolated thunderstorm. Rain could be moderate to heavy at times, resulting in debris flows on the most prone burn scars. Light showers are possible Sunday, then a new disturbance arriving from offshore on Monday will bring a push of very moist marine air with a higher probability of light showers. The rest of next week appears dry with near normal temperatures.

#### .SATURDAY...

Sky/weather......Partly sunny (45-55 percent) then becoming cloudy (95-100 percent) around noon. A chance of light rain showers in the morning, then rain showers and isolated thunderstorms in the afternoon.

Max temperature....Around 67. Min humidity......55 percent.

Eye level winds.....Southeast winds around 3 mph shifting to the southwest in the afternoon.

Wind (20 ft)......Southeast winds 3 to 7 mph in the morning shifting to southwest then west around 5 mph in the afternoon. Gusty and erratic winds expected

near thunderstorms in the afternoon.

Mixing height......6400 ft AGL.

Transport winds.....Southeast around 6 mph becoming west 5 mph.

#### FIRE BEHAVIOR


#### **GENERAL:**

Low pressure system remains over the fire area with a continued chance of rain. There is a 35% chance for isolated thundercells that could produce significant rainfall amounts. Otherwise expect trace to 0.1 inches.

Today, moderately higher temps and lower RHs will help to reveal areas near the perimeter where concentrated heat remains. Fine dead, live herbaceous, and live woody fuels will continue to be resistant to fire spread. Activity will be primarily confined to concentrations of timber litter and heavy logs where rate of spread will be minimal.

Gravity hazards such as rolling material and falling trees continue to have the potential to come to rest in receptive fuelbeds outside the fire perimeter. Isolated torching is possible where intense heat exists under dense canopy with ladder fuels. Spotting potential is very low with a forecast PIG in the 20-30% range.

Rebound of ERC values will lag behind the return of warmer, drier weather conditions.

#### SPECIFIC:

<u>Chilcoot:</u> Minimal fire spread. Fire activity will be primarily concentrated in jackpots of heavy logs (TL7) and areas of high load conifer litter (TL5). Falling snags and rollout may find receptive fuels outside current perimeter.

<u>Ridge:</u> Minimal fire spread. Fire activity will be primarily concentrated on the west perimeter under dense canopy where heavy fuels are sheltered. Falling snags and rollout may continue to pose a risk to containment lines.

<u>Might:</u> Foggy conditions may mix with smoke and severely impact visibility. Snags and burning logs high on the slope will continue to consume and roll downhill.

#### **AIR OPERATIONS:**

Part sun in the A.M. shifting to cloudy with chance of rain in the P.M. Best air for operations earlier in the day.

#### FIRE BEHAVIOR SAFETY:

Douglas fir snags tend to rot out in sections and break off in 20 ft chunks from the top. Fire in the tree can expediate this process. Look up when examining fire weakened trees to ensure the top is safe and secure.

#### Hazards & Risks

**<u>Fire Camp Safety:</u>** We usually don't think of Fire Camp as a dangerous place but camp has a few hazards to look out for:

- Trip hazards such as stairs, tent stakes, cables and wires are abundant.
- Vehicle traffic in and around parking areas and driving through camp.
- Electrical shock from all the power cords and power strips plugged in our tents, kitchen area, hand wash stations and shower unit.
- Wildlife and insects.
- Walking and talking or texting on our cell phones.
- Sharp objects such as scissors, tacks, saws and nails.
- Adverse weather; to name just a few Fire Camp Watch Outs.
   Sooooo pay attention to your surroundings and avoid distractions!

**ATV/UTV Safety:** UTV & ATV's are great fireline tools to expedite equipment and personnel movement around more remote areas of the fire, HOWEVER there are regulations that govern the operation and safety of the vehicles. Operators (drivers) must have had the appropriate level of training by their agency. Also, per Forest Service regulation:

FS – UTV Helmet (for fire use) – must meet the policy within the Safety Handbook (6709.11), Chapter 70, 71.12; Exhibit 01 states "Specialized Equipment, such as ATVs, UTVs, Dirt Bikes, Snowmobiles (Department of Transportation-approved helmet)." Wearing hardhats while driving or riding on a UTV is not allowed. Forest Service policy provides no exception to the helmet requirement for low speeds, smooth travel surfaces, or administrative use. UTV Helmet (for fire use) requirements are the same as ATV use. Helmets must meet Snell, or DOT ANSI certification. A 3/4 face model meeting Snell or DOT certification is acceptable for use. Use of half "shorty" helmets requires a JHA/RA for fireline use approved by the Incident Commander or relevant Line Officer and must include justification for its use.

# Resource Protection During Fire Suppression on U.S. Forest Service Land Chilcoot Ridge Fire

#### **Aquatics:**

- Do not use fire-fighting foam, gel or other chemicals within 30 feet of streams or in any ponds or wetlands.
- Keep extra jerry cans for pumps at least 10 feet from stream channels and place them on absorbent pads to prevent fuel spills
- Draft/dip water only at approved designated sites. Do not reduce water below 1/3 of original streamflow or pond level unless approved by READ.
- Keep Aerial retardant 300 feet from any stream with water in it (use retardant avoidance maps)
- Do not cut through instream wood when building line.
- Use 3/32" screens when drafting in fish-bearing streams, READs have these if needed.
- If dip site known to have invasive species must be used, disinfect bucket before moving to different dip site.

#### Dozers:

- Stop dozer line 100' from live streams, finish with handline. No dozer line in wet areas, meadows or trails.
- If opening roads with dozer, identify and avoid culverts, push material to outside of road shoulder keeping material out of ditches.

#### Meadows, Cultural, Owls, Bridges:

- Do not drive vehicles into meadows; use low water pressure (no straight streaming) and no digging, in order to protect soils/plant bulbs; don't construct drop points, parking areas or safety zones; fall hazard trees away from mapped site location.
- Notify resource advisor if cultural resources are encountered. Leave all artifacts in place and provide GPS coordinates for locations.
- Avoid suppression activities in and around owl cores where possible.
- Review bridge permit requirements prior to transporting equipment over Forest bridges. All
  equipment shall be transported by lowboy or trailer over bridges, no equipment walking.

#### **Personal Hygiene:**

- Bury your business and paperwork a minimum of 6" deep, at least 200' from any water source.
- Do not introduce soap, shampoo or other chemicals into rivers, streams, or ponds/lakes.

If in doubt ask a READ, we are here to help you in fire suppression efforts while trying to minimize damage to resource values.

# **Logistics Message**

**WEED WASH: Please go through weed wash if: 1)** You have just arrived at the incident or you are going to demob, **2)** You are assigned *to*, or reassigned *from* Div H, **3)** You are being reassigned from one fire to another.

Please adhere to camp traffic patterns and posted signs. Do not park your vehicles within the designated tent area to the north side of the base.

The shower gets busy between 2000 and 2130. Avoid showers during these hours and you might spend less time in line. A second shower is scheduled to arrive on Monday.

IMPORTANT ROAD RESTRICTIONS AHEAD: On September 10, construction crews will be working on the bridge just to the west of the Chilcoot base entrance. On that day, and for approximately 1 month, there will be a 10' 6" width limitation with traffic control systems in place. There are no exemptions to this. We are working on alternate routes for large vehicles.
