**WEATHER DISCUSSION:** The upper-level low is expected to begin to shift to the east on Sunday in response to several weak and shallow waves moving into the Pacific Northwest. This will keep the mention of showers in the forecast Sunday and Monday. The heaviest showers may likely be Sunday night. Temperatures will remain on the cool side of normal through Monday. Morning fog and low stratus will be probable in the valleys and canyons both Sunday morning and Monday morning. Tuesday will be a transition day as the closed low kicks off to the east and another shallow wave moves along the B.C. border and northern Washington on Wednesday. Any precipitation with the Wednesday system will remain north of the area, but it will keep the flow westerly keeping temperatures on the cool side of normal.

## FIRE BEHAVIOR

#### **GENERAL:**

A couple additional days of below normal temps and elevated RH/precip will keep a lid on fire activity.

Activity is confined to isolated pockets of heavies interior and in inaccessible areas of the fire perimeter.

Additionally, smoldering and creeping continues in the heavy duff layer under mature timber. Heavily managed stands of timber and plantations have received sufficient moisture penetration to eliminate most remaining heat.

Gravity hazards such as rolling material and falling trees continue to have the potential to come to rest in receptive fuelbeds outside the fire perimeter. Isolated torching is possible where intense heat exists under dense canopy with ladder fuels.

Spotting potential is very low with a forecast PIG in the 20-30% range. Current 1000 hr fuel moisture = 17% FM TL3 (Moderate Load Conifer Litter) ::: Rate of Spread 1.5 ch/hr ::: Flamelength 1 ft

## Local Thresholds that Shout Watch Out

Combination of any of these factors:

20' winds over 13 mph ::: RH less than 25% ::: Temperature over 85° ::: 1000hr Fuel Moisture less than 12%

## SPECIFIC:

<u>Chilcoot:</u> Low spread potential along areas of the fire perimeter with indirect containment line, primarily in DIVS Delta and DIVS Juliet. Where jackpots of large logs and heavy conifer litter exist, expect slightly higher flamelengths and rate of spread. Fire activity will remain minimal and handtools will continue to be an appropriate tactic based on flamelength.



<u>Ridge:</u> Minimal fire activity. Remaining heat will be primarily concentrated under dense canopy where heavy fuels and thick duff are sheltered. Falling snags and rollout may continue to pose a risk to containment lines.



## **AIR OPERATIONS:**

Partly cloudy the morning before heavy clouds roll back in during the afternoon with a chance of precipitation. Best chance for air for operations is earlier in the day.

#### FIRE BEHAVIOR SAFETY:

Deep pockets of underground fuels such as stumps, rotten logs, and large root systems can hold heat for weeks and even months. These low-oxygen burn environments can create extremely hot conditions. Be aware of hidden sink holes and cautious when traversing near very large stumps. Avoid spraying water directly into these areas.

## **Hazards & Risks**

<u>Chipper & Chainsaw Operations:</u> Be sure to use only qualified and or certified chipper and chainsaw operators. Use of PPE is mandatory!

Consider work proximity to each other; cutters in one area while the chipper crew follows up with the chipper. Establish traffic control when working alongside roadways. Watch your footing when working on steep cut banks and watch for brush roll-out landing on the highway. Use caution when using the directional chipper spray nozzle and keep personnel away from the spray zone.

<u>Safety Zones:</u> A safety zone is an area where a firefighter can survive without a fire shelter. The separation distance between firefighter and flames should be at least 4X the maximum flame height. This is based on flat terrain and no wind conditions. Safety Zones that are downwind and/or upslope from the fire will require larger separation distances. Reference your IRPG for detailed safety zone size calculations. Ensure your escape route is clear of hazards and known to all.

**Lookouts:** Posting Lookouts is an invaluable tool for gathering information on fire behavior & weather and it's potential impacts to crews working on the fireline. Lookouts should be experienced, competent & trusted. They should have knowledge of crew locations, escape routes, safety zones, trigger points and possess a map, weather kit, watch & IAP.

**SUBJECT: CHAIN SAW CUTS TO SWAMPERS** 

AREA OF CONCERN: Chain Saw Operations

**DISTRIBUTION:** All Agency Chain Saw Operators, Module Leaders, Fire Safety

Officers, Forest Safety Managers

**DISCUSSION:** There has been a marked increase in injuries to swampers involving chain saw strikes and struck-by incidents (i.e., when the swamper is hit by the tree or parts of the tree being felled) this 2022 fire and field season.

During saw operations involving saw teams the sawyer may need to operate the chain saw in close proximity to the swamper. This presents unique safety considerations.

Each year, there are swampers who receive lacerations to their hands, arms, or legs by working too close to a running chain saw. Chain saw cuts are not simple cuts like that made by a knife; they are significant and complex wounds that happen extremely quickly. Chain saws shred flesh and can quickly remove muscles, tendons, and bone.

The sawyer and the swamper have a shared responsibility to each other's safety, as well as that of other firefighters in the area.

**MITIGATION MEASURES:** To reduce risk of injuries due to chain saw strikes, the sawyer and swamper need to be aware of and avoid the strike zone. The strike zone is a 360-degree radius around a sawyer at a distance equivalent to the sawyer's arm length plus the length of the chain saw and bar. This is a minimum, and may need to be expanded due to other factors such as fatigue, experience, etc.

During tree felling operations, the sawyer is responsible for cutting area control. This means not allowing anyone within a distance of 2 1/2 the height of the tree being felled - including the swamper.

# Resource Protection During Fire Suppression on U.S. Forest Service Land Chilcoot Ridge Fire

## Aquatics:

- Do not use fire-fighting foam, gel or other chemicals within 30 feet of streams or in any ponds or wetlands.
- Keep extra jerry cans for pumps at least 10 feet from stream channels and place them on absorbent pads to prevent fuel spills
- Draft/dip water only at approved designated sites. Do not reduce water below 1/3 of original streamflow or pond level unless approved by READ.
- Keep Aerial retardant 300 feet from any stream with water in it (use retardant avoidance maps)
- Do not cut through instream wood when building line.
- Use 3/32" screens when drafting in fish-bearing streams, READs have these if needed.
- If dip site known to have invasive species must be used, disinfect bucket before moving to different dip site.

## Dozers:

- Stop dozer line 100' from live streams, finish with handline. No dozer line in wet areas, meadows or trails.
- If opening roads with dozer, identify and avoid culverts, push material to outside of road shoulder keeping material out of ditches.

## Meadows, Cultural, Owls, Bridges:

- Do not drive vehicles into meadows; use low water pressure (no straight streaming) and no digging, in order to protect soils/plant bulbs; don't construct drop points, parking areas or safety zones; fall hazard trees away from mapped site location.
- Notify resource advisor if cultural resources are encountered. Leave all artifacts in place and provide GPS coordinates for locations.
- Avoid suppression activities in and around owl cores where possible.
- Review bridge permit requirements prior to transporting equipment over Forest bridges. *All* equipment shall be transported by lowboy or trailer over bridges, **no equipment walking**.

## Personal Hygiene:

- Bury your business and paperwork a minimum of 6" deep, at least 200' from any water source.
- Do not introduce soap, shampoo or other chemicals into rivers, streams, or ponds/lakes.

If in doubt ask a READ, we are here to help you in fire suppression efforts while trying to minimize damage to resource values.
