
Fuels in the fire area are primarily composed of *Timber Litter*, and *Timber Understory with moss/lichen present in most stands*. Mature conifer stands with western hemlock and Douglas fir present, generally have heavy surface fuel loading. 30 to 50+ year old second growth conifer stands contain needle litter and some down woody debris. Brush and reproduction present in areas with less dense canopies.

OUTPUTS

Rebound of ERC values will lag behind the return of warmer, drier weather conditions.



Minimal fire behavior is expected with little to no perimeter growth. Continued smoldering in duff, larger down logs, and forest debris.

FIRE BEHAVIOR SPECIFIC: BRANCH I and II,

Fuels continue to have elevated fuel moistures which will lead to minimal fire activity expected today with little to no perimeter growth. Areas of heavy dead and downed fuels will continue to consume along with ground fire in the duff. Burning standing dead trees will continue to burn creating arial hazards. Keep an eye out on areas where burning material rolling down slope can cross underslung lines. Even though these spot fires may not spread with the high fuel moistures there is a possibility as we continue in this drying trend, they could spread to surrounding fuels. Also pay attention to trees with fire in the tops as they can send spot fires across your lines.

Initial Attack: In the event resources respond to a new start, recognize that fuels and topography may be different than areas you have previously worked in.

AIR OPERATIONS: Some fog and low clouds early in morning, otherwise mostly sunny. Inversion lifting around 1100 hours.

SAFETY

Test your fire behavior skills, anticipate what could happen, be prepared and plan accordingly.

TOPICS:

LACK OF COMMUNICATION

Areas exist within the perimeter and along transport routes where communication is not an absolute. Alternate channels may need to be used if the Incident Command net doesn't work. Backup command, Forest Net and human repeaters may be used. Areas of poor communication need to be evaluated and resource accountability implemented for resources traveling in and out of said areas.



HYGIENE

Camp crud is showing itself. Some simple practices (just like those we practice at home) can reduce your chances of contracting it. Shower at reasonable intervals. You are constantly shedding skin; get rid of it! Brush and floss every day, preferably after every meal. This will minimize the buildup of bacteria in your mouth. <u>Wash your hands!</u> Hand to mouth or hand to nose will spread bacteria or viruses. <u>Wash before meals, after bathroom breaks or whenever</u> <u>you touch something that is frequented by other hands.</u> Keep an alcohol based sanitizer available at all times. Get adequate rest! Try to get at least 8 hours of sleep every night.

Heavy Equipment	Post lookouts around equipment work areas. Establish communications with equipment boss and operator. Do not work down-slope from equipment. Follow agency guidelines for chipping operations.	HIGH
Physical Factors	Maintain hydration schedule. Closely monitor work rate and implement rest periods. Maintain nutrition. Ensure adequate work/rest.	MODERATE



 - Waterbar depths for **hand lines** should be at least 4 inches; total height from bottom of ditch to top of waterbar should average at least 8 inches and not exceed 12 inches.

EMERGENCY PLAN INCIDENT WITHIN AN INCIDENT

ON SCENE INCIDENT COMMANDER

In the event of an accident or medical incident of any size, your primary responsibility is to ENSURE that the victim(s) receive prompt and effective Triage, Treatment, Extrication and Transport.

- ENSURE THE MEDICAL INCIDENT REPORT IN THE INCIDENT ACTION PLAN IS BEING USED AND FOLLOWED- *<u>IF DETERMINED TO BE A</u> <u>GREEN, DO NOT DECLARE EMERGENCY TRAFFIC AND ONLY COMPLETE</u> <u>LINE 1-4 ON MIR*.</u>
- Conduct size-up of the incident, including nature of accident, number type of resources involved, latitude and longitude location (DD° MMM.MM format). Notify incident communications center and supervisor. Request assistance as needed.
- Order and coordinate medical and support response to the accident.
- Evaluate special needs (law enforcement, haz mat, etc.).
- Clear the command frequency if medical emergency. Coordinate with incident communications and air attack for air medical transportation needs.
- Preserve and photograph the scene for accident investigation.
- Remain aware of surroundings and the status of the main incident (delegate personnel to monitor the main fire) to ensure safety of medical treatment personnel.
- Until relieved, supervise and manage all personnel involved at the incident scene.
