TOPICS:

SITUATIONAL AWARENESS

Developing and maintaining situational awareness is a three-step process that includes:
1. Perception: Gathering information about what is happening around you.
2. Understanding: Making sense of the information you gather.
3. Prediction: Anticipating future events to prevent bad outcomes.

While situational awareness is the foundation for good decision-making, it is not flawless. Unexpected and novel events happen, even to the most experienced responders.

Wildland firefighting is often physically demanding work performed over extended periods of time. Lack of sleep and hydration, coupled with smoke inhalation, can lead to mental fatigue, and can decrease situational awareness.

Not recognizing the hazards, being unfamiliar with local fuels and fuel conditions, or not understanding the plan will lead to a lack of situational awareness. You don't know what you don't know.

Pay attention to your environment, ask for a good briefing, and make sure you understand the intent. Recognize hazards, communicate them and avoid or remove them.

Every day on a fire is a learning day.

Don't stand too close to guys that are always bandaged up.



- DEPTH AND WIDTH: Waterbars need to be cut into surface, do not simply push up soil.
 - Waterbar depths for **dozer lines** should be at least 6 inches; total height from bottom of ditch to the top of the waterbar should average at least 18 inches and not exceed 24 inches.
 - Waterbar depths for **hand lines** should be at least 4 inches; total height from bottom of ditch to top of waterbar should average at least 8 inches and not exceed 12 inches.

EMERGENCY PLAN INCIDENT WITHIN AN INCIDENT

ON SCENE INCIDENT COMMANDER

In the event of an accident or medical incident of any size, your primary responsibility is to ENSURE that the victim(s) receive prompt and effective Triage, Treatment, Extrication and Transport.

- ENSURE THE MEDICAL INCIDENT REPORT IN THE INCIDENT ACTION PLAN IS BEING USED AND FOLLOWED- *<u>IF DETERMINED TO BE A</u> <u>GREEN, DO NOT DECLARE EMERGENCY TRAFFIC AND ONLY COMPLETE</u> <u>LINE 1-4 ON MIR*.</u>
- Conduct size-up of the incident, including nature of accident, number type of resources involved, latitude and longitude location (DD° MMM.MM format). Notify incident communications center and supervisor. Request assistance as needed.
- Order and coordinate medical and support response to the accident.
- Evaluate special needs (law enforcement, haz mat, etc.).
- Clear the command frequency if medical emergency. Coordinate with incident communications and air attack for air medical transportation needs.
- Preserve and photograph the scene for accident investigation.
- Remain aware of surroundings and the status of the main incident (delegate personnel to monitor the main fire) to ensure safety of medical treatment personnel.
- Until relieved, supervise and manage all personnel involved at the incident scene.
