<u>WEATHER DISCUSSION</u>: High pressure building over western Oregon delivers a strong warming and drying trend through the end of the week. Changes will be subtle today (Wed) then ramp up for Thursday into Friday. Winds shifting to the northeast-north today then becoming very light during our warmest and driest days.

WEDNESDAY:

WEATHER: Scattered marine stratus over the ridgetops in the morning, becoming mostly sunny by 1000.


Fuels in the fire area are primarily composed of *Timber Litter*, and *Timber Understory with moss/lichen present in most stands*. Mature conifer stands with western hemlock and Douglas fir present, generally have heavy surface fuel loading. 30 to 50+ year old second growth conifer stands contain needle litter and some down woody debris. Brush and reproduction present in areas with less dense canopies.

Dinner, Brice, Grizzly- Forecast -ERC 71st percentile. Yesterday's obs. 1hr-12%, 10hr-17%, 100hr-15%, 1000hr-18% Chilcoot & Ridge- Forecast -ERC 81st percentile. Yesterday's obs. 1hr-12%, 10hr-20%, 100hr-16%, 1000hr-18%

OUTPUTS

FIRE BEHAVIOR GENERAL:

High pressure building over the area will start to bring slightly warmer and drier conditions today compared to yesterday. Fuel conditions will be similar to yesterday. Fire spread potential will remain similar as to what was seen yesterday. Creeping and smoldering in surface fuels will be the most common fire behavior in areas with active burning. The potential for mature timber stands to experience isolated torching where lichen is present still exists and could create increased spotting potential when near the fire's edge. Lichen will become more available to burn as humidity in the valleys dips down to 30%.



FIRE BEHAVIOR SPECIFIC:

Dinner, Brice, Grizzly, Chilcoot, and Ridge

Smoldering and creeping with isolated torching will be the main types of fire. Fire spread potential will still be largely dependent on location, aspect, and exposure/sheltering. Southern aspects may see areas where 1-hr and 10-hr fuels become more available to carry fire as solar radiation reaches its peak between 1100-1500.

Areas of heavy dead and downed fuels will continue to consume and could initiate torching in lichen covered ladder fuels.

Fires with black edge up to containment features should experience minimal fire behavior and isolated to interior portions of the fire.

Initial Attack: In the event resources respond to a new start, recognize that fuels, topography, and conditions may be different than areas you have previously worked in.

AIR OPERATIONS: Slight inversion breaking around 10 am.

Continue transition of new resources onto incident. Check communications medical, and air operations plan in IAP. If you're leaving, close the loop by identifying completed or remaining work items, hazards, work procedures etc. If you're arriving, ask questions. Get to know new partners, share what you know, help each other be successful as soon as possible. When in transition, things slow down. Fight fire with this in mind. Ensure new resources are accounted for, and control retained.

TRANSPORTATION SAFETY

By air, sea, or land, that's how we're getting there. Ensure proper safety procedures and hazard mitigation are identified and being followed for whatever transport method people are using. Be particularly careful driving home as the incident doesn't end until everyone is home.

EVERYONE IS A SAFETY OFFICER

There are 800+ people currently assigned to this incident. Each person needs to be a safety officer for the welfare of themselves, their co-workers, and their families. We are all counting on eachother. Your actions in identifying hazards or potential safety problems and taking the time to mitigate them is a critical responsibility in your position and will help to ensure the safest work environment possible for everyone.

- 1. Eyes not on the task Texting while you drive or looking at the scenery.
- 2. Mind not on task Talking on the phone or radio while driving.

- 4. Losing our balance or traction We are driving too fast for the road conditions.



Respiratory Hygiene/Cough Etiquette

What is respiratory hygiene/cough etiquette?

These are infection prevention measures designed to limit the transmission of respiratory pathogens spread by droplet or airborne routes, such as camp crud, flu, RSV, and COVID-Implement measures to prevent the spread of respiratory infections from anyone in a health care setting with signs or symptoms.

- Following respiratory hygiene/cough etiquette principles: Fire
 personnel should be advised to cover their nose and mouth with a
 tissue when coughing or sneezing. If using a tissue, they should
 immediately throw away the tissue away after use and wash or
 sanitize their hands as described above.
- Performing hand hygiene: When soap and water are available all fire personnel should wash their hands often for at least 20 seconds, especially after coughing or sneezing. This is especially true when a fire personnel's hands are visibly dirty, after touching commonly touched surfaces like porta potty doors, tables, and equipment, after using the toilet, or before eating. If soap and water are not readily available, alcohol-based hand sanitizers with at least 60% alcohol should be used.
- Social distance
- Limit time in enclosed areas
