Assumptions: (DEJA'VU forecast) Fuels got wet yesterday, and will likely get even wetter today. Fire behavior will be "conditional" today due to changing conditions including wind and additional rain. Potential fire spread will be limited by extent and amount of precipitation, and wind. The effects of wind and rain have not been uniform across the fire area. Valley and ridgetops will be affected by wind and scattered showers through the day. Heavy sheltered fuels will continue to burn until a canopy penetrating rain occurs. The Flat fire continues to have scattered heat sources and will be affected by similar rain/wind.

Weather Summary See attached Fire Weather Forecast Fire Behavior Summary

Fuels in the fire area include very high load fluffy Timber Litter (TL9), closed canopy Timber Litter (TL5) with needles, branches/heavy fuel concentrations, and large Timber with Understory (TU5) shrubby open timber canopy. Primary tree species include mixed sizes of Douglas Fir/mixed conifer timber stands. Shrub fields and understory species include Oregon Myrtlewood, maple(s), manzanita, other shrub-form hardwoods. Numerous snags and heavy fuel concentrations (often shrub covered) are common throughout all areas. Live fuels (shrubs) are seasonally dry and may contribute to fire spread. Moss is common in timber stands as a ladder/spotting fuel. Gorse (highly flammable shrub) is common in timber harvest areas, especially on west side of fire area.

<u>Today's potential fire behavior</u>: Expect wind/rain produce limited fire activity on steep fuel rich slopes. Fire behavior may include pockets of surface fire spread under canopy sheltered steep slopes. Rollout and falling snags on steep slopes may accelerate backing and produce flare-ups. Gorse may burn with wind even when damp. Snags will fall more frequently due to length of time burning and increased wind. <u>Heavy fuels (logs, stumps) will retain long-term heat due to a whole summer of drying.</u> Words for the day "Smoldering and Creeping".

* Fine fuel moisture= 16% + (exposed). Probability of Ignition 0%-5%. Group torch spotting to <.25 mile.

Specific Assignments:

FLAT – Monitor smoke location and characteristics. Evaluate weather, including wind speed and rainfall. Low reburn potential with area wide rain on fuels containing unburned pockets, fire killed shrubs, and ragged edge burn pattern.

ANVIL – Expect areas of minimal fire behavior, fire spread is unlikely. Some upslope surface spread withbacking may occur under sheltered dense timber canopy. Rolling materials may cause flare-ups. Several areas of likely slope reversal may introduce burning material across creeks. Burning/falling snags may contribute to flare-ups, and rollout.

Air Operations: Ridge top wind may affect approach/departure for bucket drops. Clouds on higher terrain likely in the morning...

Safety

<u>Transition day.....short period to get up to speed, share fire behavior observations.</u> Review the Fire Orders and Watchout situations as they relate to the assignment....anticipate fire behavior and weather hazards, plan your actions in advance. Share and discuss the Fire Weather Forecast and Fire Behavior Forecast. LCES should be reviewed more frequently......pull out the belt weather kit, post lookouts......

Deja'vu fire behavior safety message - Varying amounts of moisture in the fire area, some fuels were sheltered from moisture. Drying rates may accelerate with wind and warming. Fuels that have consumed leave hot ash pits. Fire weakened snags and trees are not to be trusted....maintain situational awareness of your surroundings at all times – the situation may change.

Flash Flood Talking Points

- In a landslide, masses of rock, earth or debris move down a slope. Debris and mud flows are rivers of rock, earth, and other debris saturated with water.
- They develop when water rapidly accumulates in the ground, during heavy rainfall or rapid snowmelt, changing the earth into a flowing river of mud or "slurry."
- They can flow rapidly, striking with little or no warning at avalanche speeds. They also can travel several miles from their source, growing in size as they pick up trees, boulders, cars and other materials.
- Move away from the path of a landslide or debris flow as quickly as possible. The danger from a mudflow increases near stream channels and with prolonged heavy rains.

Days of Rest

- Still lots of fire season left to go.
- Ensure that all crew members are taking care of themselves and getting adequate rest to rehab both mentally and physically.
- Slow tempo days can still be productive and worthwhile for crew resiliency.
- Remember for every 2 hours of work that you should be getting 1 hour of rest.

Weed wash when:

- Checking into the incident as well as checking out.
- Going into and leaving the Anvil Fire area to keep gorse and scotch broom off public, tribal, and private lands.
- There are currently 3 weed washes: Anvil Camp, at the intersection of Cape Blanco Rd. and Hwy 101, and up the Elk River Road just east of DP 732.

Gorse is a very thorny shrub that was introduced from Europe in the late 1800's. It has since become the #1 most invasive species on the southern Oregon coast, taking over forest and farmlands and playing a key role in more rapid spread of wildfire. Seeds remain viable in the soil for 80 years or more, making prevention key. PLEASE DO YOUR PART AND WEED WASH DAILY!







FISH SCREENS: On all foot valves on pumps and tenders on Sixes, Illinois, Rogue, Lawson Creek, Hunter Creek, Elk River, Panther Creek, Butler Bar and any other fish-bearing streams. These are in addition to screens on pump hoses, and READs can/will deliver!

PREVENT PORT-ORFORD-CEDAR ROOT DISEASE: At draft sites use bleach for water sources identified by resource advisors unless advised otherwise. Mix one gallon of bleach per 1,000 gallons of water in the engine or water tender. DO NOT dump leftover bleach on ground or near water bodies as it is lethal to aquatic life.

BLEACH REQUIRED AT DRAFT SITES:

- East of DP640 on the Sixes River
- East of confluence of State Creek (Red Rock) on the Elk River

LOOK FOR FLAGGING: Orange and black polka dot and yellow flagging mark resource areas to protect. Do not disturb.

Incident Replacement Guidelines

Prior to release from the incident, personnel may request replacement of standard equipment and supplies (NFES) that were damaged, lost, consumed, or worn out during the incident. Personnel must document the request on the most applicable form – Incident Replacement Requisition (OF-315), Saw Parts Order, or General Message (OF-213). This request should include a description of the use on the incident and/or why the item(s) need to be replaced. Requests must be signed by the **Division Supervisor** then approved by the **Operations Section Chief** prior to taking to Supply. Worn out or damaged property will be turned into the Supply Unit.

Approval for replacement of non-standard items (**Non NFES**) may need to be approved by the Incident Business Advisor (INBA). You should initiate this process at least two days prior to demob.

Personnel who need to replace/repair damaged property will document the request on an OF-289, Property Loss or Damage Report. This form requires Incident Supervisor recommendation as well as Subject Matter Expert determination, if appropriate. The form will then need to be turned into the Comp/Claims Unit Leader, who will track the claim and facilitate approval by the Finance Section Chief (FSC). Additional documentation may be required by the FSC. The FSC will decide, or recommend to the INBA, as to whether the items can be replaced or repaired with incident funds. After approval, Supply/Ordering will issue S numbers.

Items originally provided through use of preparedness funds which need to be replaced due to **normal wear and tear** (e.g. worn out tire tread, worn out chain saw bar, 5-yr old GPS that stops working, etc.) should be accomplished using home unit funds, not incident funds. If government property was damaged on the incident due to a specific event, (e.g. wind event destroys a tent) the incident could, upon receipt of required documentation and proof of damage, authorize replacement. **Replacement of non standard items that are worn out is the responsibility of the home unit.**

The OF-289, Property Loss or Damage Report is available at the Finance yurt or on the linktr.ee by accessing the QR code.
