Leaders Intent

- 1. Human Life is the most important value to be protected. There is no higher value than that of our responders and the public. Utilize deliberate risk assessment and Incident Strategic Alignment Process to ensure hazards are identified and response is commensurate with values at risk.
- 2. Limit impacts to communities at risk. Monitor fire behavior, smoke impacts and fire growth; respond as needed to protect life, property, infrastructure, improvements, recreation, cultural, natural resources, and other identified values at risk.
- 3. Apply methods and implement suppression and repair strategies appropriate to the values at risk, and where they will have the highest probability of success. Suppression and repair activities will be coordinated with resource advisor and in accordance with approved suppression repair plan.
- Ensure the timely and accurate dissemination of information and maintain positive relationships with cooperating agencies and local landowners; along with identified elected state and local officials, business leaders and media contacts.
- 5. Manage incident and assigned resources cost effectively, commensurate with the direction of the Agency Administrators and values to be protected.
- Manage human resources assigned to the incident in a manner that promotes a positive harassment free work environment, ensure all are treated with dignity and respect. There will be zero tolerance for drug and alcohol use or possession for those assigned to this incident.

Management Objectives

- Consider, communicate and plan for the safety and wellbeing of assigned personnel, resources and the public, prior to engaging in any and all incident related activities. Emphasize safety in all that we do.
- Engage and limit the negative effects of fire suppression activities to natural resources. Suppression repair plan identifies specific actions needed to stabilize the adverse effects in these fire areas.
- Work with BAER Team to support access and completion of burned area assessment.
- Work with Willamette National Forest Timber READ to facilitate danger tree removal to reduce roadside hazards.
- Protect communities at risk, private properties, industrial timber, family forests, recreational areas, wildlife, cultural and natural resources, Eugene Water and Electric Board Dam, H.J. Andrews Experimental Forest, Hwy 126 and other identified values at risk.
- Continue to monitor fire behavior, activity and growth and react accordingly.
- Respond to new starts as requested by host agencies.
- Utilize Turn-back Standards document to provide clear direction as to the desired conditions and the requirements for transfer of command for the Bedrock, Lookout, Horse Creek, Pothole, and Pete's Lake Fires back to host unit or to another Incident Management Team.

FUELS:

Fuels in the fire area consist of Timber Litter (TL5) and Timber Understory (TU5) and lichen in the canopy. Fire behavior predictions are for the hottest and driest period of the day, gusts could increase fire behavior rates.

FIRE BEHAVIOR SPECIFIC:

Petes Lake & Lookout Fire: Fuels will lag in recovery from the recent precipitation. Expect to see smoldering of stumpholes, duff and heavy fuels.

Bedrock, Pothole and Horse Creek Fire: Fuels will lag in recovery from the recent precipitation. Smoldering of protected fuels should be the extent for fire activity.

IA: Conditions exist for slow moving fire spread with flame lengths that direct attack should be effective. Open areas with grass will have highest rates of spread, shaded fuels will be resistant to burning.

AIR OPERATIONS:

Cloudy morning with fog is likely to limit visibility, some clearing may occur in the afternoon.

With rain coming take a look at the pumps and any fuel storage. Please ensure containment trays are empty, with fresh pads. Use visqueen, p-cord to make a tent over the pump and fuel where possible. Driving around please look for plugged culvert and ditches, and make sure water can flow even if you can't do a full repair.

Engineering and Roads

- Do not track heavy equipment on paved roads without the proper mitigations (ie. street grousers, rubber mats, etc.).
- If any road issues or concerns are encountered, please contact a REAF.

Dozer Lines

- Please work with Resource Advisors to clear proposed dozer lines.
- Please minimize the depth of the dozer line to the least extent required to meet objectives. Deep cuts are expensive, time consuming, and difficult to repair.

Heritage & Cultural

All cultural resources and human remains are protected by law. <u>Leave them in place- no collecting</u>. Call Resource Advisor if cultural resource like arrowheads, flakes/chips, or historic artifacts like cans & bottles are found and they will investigate.

Noxious Weeds

WEED WASH STATION:

- The Weed Wash stations are operational and located at Lookout Staging (Rock Quarry) and Lookout ICP
- Please use the weed wash upon arrival at the incident, and during demob
- Avoid the following weed: Slender False Brome and Spotted Knapweed

REDUCE THE SPREAD: Brush off packs & boots (especially laces) before leaving fire camp.





Tree Felling Operations

Please keep equipment on road surface to the greatest extent possible Log Processing:

- Utilize existing openings and landings for decking, ditch lines/roadside is acceptable
- · Process trees down to a 6" top (small end diameter). Use remaining for firewood logs, rehab, or chip
- Preferred Log Lengths (maximize length whenever possible): 41 foot Max 17 foot Min
- 2' increments below 41', keeping logs as long as possible (41', 39', 37', etc....) Process unburnt trees on the unburnt side of the fireline. Process burnt trees on the burnt side of the fireline.
- Keep processed slash and tops out of decks and off roads
- If possible, sort decks by species and log lengths

Snags and Hazard Trees:

Old growth is a key value. Limit snagging to operational needs & limit bucking to retain long bowls of large felled trees or snags.

Water Quality and Fisheries

AERIAL DIPPING:

- Aerial dipping should only occur at approved dip sites. Blue River Res. has a use restriction to facilitate dipping. Check with your REAF for approval of dipping sites.
- Be sure to wash buckets when new aerial resources arrive at the fire, when switching dips sites, or when returning to the fire from off forest.

WATER DRAFTNG:

- Limited Drafting is available at the bridge across Lookout Creek on the 1506 road in section 28. Check with the REAF for additional drafting locations as needed.
- Utilize fish screens when in fish bearing waterbodies (REAFs have these available).
- Maintain sufficient flow as to not dewater downstream reaches
- Utilize splash pans and absorbent pads. REAFs will assist if given the location.

CHIPPING STANDARDS:

- Provide a 30- foot buffer of no chipping at water crossings or culverts.
- Do not place chips into road ditch.
- Do not chip onto a steep slope where chips will slide back into the ditch.
- Broadcast chipped material, ensuring that chips are no more than 4" deep.

SITUATIONAL AWARENESS

There are four main characteristics of **Situational Awareness** including Observation, Orientation, Decision, and Action

- **Observation** involves constantly monitoring the people, the environment and actions taking place around you.
- **Orientation** encourages you to think about what is around you and how you're processing information based on your own experience.
- The **Decision** has you weigh all your options and look for what is the best possible outcome within your capabilities.
- Action is the last step, and you will then use all the previous information to protect yourself.

The work we do can become second nature, create complacency, and prevent us from intentionally processing new information. Situational awareness is a critical skill, not only for decision making but also for accident prevention.

- Pay close attention to your actions in high stress or high workload situations.
- Incorporate the four situational awareness characteristics when starting a new project, working in a new environment or with new people.
- Create a habit of regularly assessing your work and your work environment. Ask yourself:
 - o Is there a threat present?
 - o Is there anything I can do to reduce the threat?
 - Can I continue working safely?
- Observe warning signs! Are there any unusual or threatening issues that have changed the situation.
- Be proactive in communicating any issues or changes that you observe with others.




