### 5. GENERAL CONTROL OBJECTIVES FOR THE INCIDENT (INCLUDE ALTERNATIVES)

### Strategic Framework

Implement the full spectrum of suppression strategies that include: direct perimeter control on Pothole and Horse Creek Fires; the Lookout Fire will use a combination of direct, indirect, and monitor strategies; the Bedrock Fire will use monitor and control; and the Pete's Lake will be confinement, monitor, and point protection. Values of concern include human safety, communities, private property, commercial timber land, family timber land, Eugene Water and Electric Board Dam, Hwy 46, Hwy 126, Elk Lake Resort, and other identified infrastructure. Apply tactics that offer the highest probability of success to meet intent and objectives while considering risk to personnel.

#### **Leaders Intent**

- Human Factors: We will ensure that all personnel be treated with dignity and respect. We have zero tolerance
  for harassment, alcohol, or drug use. We will engage in all work assignments with a high degree of integrity,
  professionalism and provide excellent customer service to our responders, our agencies and our public.
- Safety & Risk Management: Firefighter, responder, aviator and public safety will be addressed through hazard identification, assessment and where practicable, mitigated.
- Operations: Prioritize missions that consider risk benefit trade-offs, provide higher probability of success given
  on scene and expected resource capability. We will consistently evaluate environmental factors and timing of
  implementing strategies.
- Agency Coordination: We will keep the Willamette National Forest, Bureau of Land Management and Oregon Department of Forestry informed of significant accomplishments, foreseen challenges and address concerns.
- Communication: We are committed to and will coordinate with the local community to enhance key
  partnerships and relationships by effectively ensuring transparent, timely and accurate communication is shared.
- Fiscal Accountability: As a responsibility and duty to the agencies and the public, we will monitor cost effective
  methods for accomplishing incident objectives and overall management of the incidents.

### **Management Objectives**

- Provide for the safety of firefighters, aviators and public through utilization of strategic and deliberate risk
  assessment. Use a deliberate risk process that might include Incident Strategic Alignment Process ISAP to
  evaluate operational hazards, probabilities of success and consequences of failure when designing operational
  missions.
- Limit impacts to communities at risk, Elk Lake Resort, private land including industrial timber, family forest lands, recreational areas, Eugene Water and Electric Board Dam, H.J. Andrews experimental forest, Hwys 46 & 126, and other identified values of risk.
- Maintain and enhance relationships with the public we serve, the agencies we are assisting and the responders that we are responsible for supporting.
- 4. Provide initial attack support to all lands in the designated TFR's and to those outside of TFR upon request.
- 5. Adhere to the control objectives, task/purpose/end state in each Division Assignment (204) to include mitigating and repairing adverse effects to resources resulting from fire suppression activities. Approved suppression repair plans include specific actions needed to stabilize the adverse effects in the fire areas.

DISCUSSION: Light rain arrives Sun morning and continues into the evening. Rain becomes a bit more scattered
after 2100, with more moderate rainfall then arriving by or shortly after 0600 Mon, and a slight (20%) chance of
thunderstorms Monday morning and afternoon. South to southeast winds increasing after 0900 Sun and
remaining strong through Monday evening.

### SUNDAY:

- WEATHER: Cloudy with a 70% chance of light rain starting between 0900-1200. Total rainfall through 2000 of 0.05-0.15".
- WIND (20 FT):
  - Lookout: Valleys/Lwr Slopes: Downslope 2-5 mph through 0900, then south 8-12 gusts to 20 mph.
     Ridges/Upper Slopes: SSE 5-10 mph through 0900 then S 10-15 mph with gusts to 25 mph.
  - o Petes Lake: SE 5-10 mph through 0900, then SE 15-20 mph with gusts 25-30 mph through 2000.
- MAX TEMPERATURES: 61-67 valleys and mid-slopes, 48-53 ridges and Pete's Lake.

  - Lookout: Valleys/Lwr Slopes: South 3-7 mph through 1000, then south 9-13 mph with gusts to 20 mph.
     Ridges/Upper Slopes: S 10-15 mph through 1000 then S 15-20 mph with gusts 25 to 30 mph.
  - o Petes Lake: SE 8-13 mph through 1200, then S 13-20 mph with gusts 25-30 mph through 2000.

### **INPUTS**

WEATHER SUMMARY: Cooling and wetting weather returns bringing good chances of measurable precipitation to all of the fires.

#### FUELS:

Continued Cooler and wetter weather remains over the fire area resulting in higher daytime RH values, cooler temperatures and chances of rain throughout the day will continue to moderate fire behavior on all fires. Continued storms move into the area bringing chances of more substantial precipitation starting on Sunday night, with increasing chances of wetting rains Monday and Tuesday.

### **OUTPUTS**

#### FIRE BEHAVIOR GENERAL:

Dead and down fuel loading in timber will be the primary burnable fuels on any of the fires. Primary activity will continue to be smoldering and creeping in duff and heavy down and dead fuels, with little to no chances of any torching or spotting.



#### Based on Peak Wx and Fuels conditions:

- Fine Dead Fuel Moisture- 11-13% Petes Lake and Lookout
- · Probability of Ignition 10-20.

### FIRE BEHAVIOR SPECIFIC:

Pete's Lake Fire: Continued creeping and smoldering of dead and down fuels and duff. No fire growth expected.

Lookout Fire: Continued consumption of dead and down heavy fuels and smoldering of duff. No spread expected.

Bedrock, Pothole, and Horse Creek: Continued consumption and smoldering of interior pockets. No growth predicted.

IA – With potential thunderstorms in the early hours, new starts are possible, but they will present low resistance to control with current weather conditions.

#### AIR OPERATIONS:

Weather will limit the needs for air operations over the next several days.

#### SAFETY

Winds will increase drastically, over the next couple of days increasing the chances of trees to fall in and outside of the fire.



## **Cognitive Load**

Cognitive workload is the level of mental effort required to accomplish a task. NASA produced a technical brief on cognitive workload in 2021. They are very concerned with task complexity and intentional on how they design and assign tasks in a space shuttle (for obvious reasons). They assess the cognitive load of tasks based on temporal, spatial, cognitive, perceptual, and physical aspects. NASA research shows that:

• Overly high and low cognitive load leads to many of the same performance issues: Increase in error frequency, frustration, fatigue, and poor awareness.

Overload and underload can be detrimental to task performance. Operators may become less likely to attend to potentially important sources of information and fail at the task.



This research corroborates what we intuitively know or have learned from experience. In the fire service community we describe this cognitive load as complexity. Unless we are rating an Incident or a Hazard Tree we usually stop at high or low complexity. It is worth considering if we shouldn't expand our formal assessments to other tasks. As we assess weather conditions and where we can continue our operational work. What can you do to keep yourself or those you supervise engaged at an acceptable cognitive workload. Some suggestions: Skill Training, Physical Training, Organization, Refurbishment, Maintenance, Administration, Applications, Networking, and Healthy Competition.





With rain coming take a look at the pumps and any fuel storage. Please ensure containment trays are empty, with fresh pads. Use visqueen and p-cord to make a tent over the pump and fuel where possible. Driving around please look for plugged culverts and ditches, and make sure water can flow even if you can't do a full

#### repair.

#### Engineering and Roads

- Do not track heavy equipment on paved roads without the proper mitigations (ie. street grousers, rubber mats, etc.).
- · If any road issues or concerns are encountered, please contact a REAF.

#### Dozer Lines

- Please work with Resource Advisors to clear proposed dozer lines.
- Please minimize the depth of the dozer line to the least extent required to meet objectives. Deep cuts are expensive, time consuming, and difficult to repair.

#### Heritage & Cultural

All cultural resources and human remains are protected by law. <u>Leave them in place- no collecting</u>. Call Resource Advisor if cultural resource like arrowheads, flakes/chips, or historic artifacts like cans & bottles are found and they will investigate.

#### Noxious Weeds

#### WEED WASH STATION:

- The Weed Wash stations are operational and located at Strubb Flat, Kickbrush & Hoodoo
- · Please use the weed wash upon arrival at the incident, and during demob
- · Avoid the following weed: Slender False Brome and Spotted Knapweed

REDUCE THE SPREAD: Brush off packs & boots (especially laces) before leaving fire camp.





#### Tree Felling Operations

Please keep equipment on road surface to the greatest extent possible

#### Log Processing:

- Utilize existing openings and landings for decking, ditch lines/roadside is acceptable
- Process trees down to a 6" top (small end diameter). Use remaining for firewood logs, rehab, or chip
- Preferred Log Lengths (maximize length whenever possible): 41 foot Max 17 foot Min
- 2' increments below 41', keeping logs as long as possible (41', 39', 37', etc....) Process unburnt trees on the unburnt side of the fireline. Process burnt trees on the burnt side of the fireline.
- Keep processed slash and tops out of decks and off roads
- If possible, sort decks by species and log lengths

#### Snags and Hazard Trees:

Old growth is a key value. Limit snagging to operational needs & limit bucking to retain long bowls of large felled trees or snags.

#### Water Quality and Fisheries

#### **AERIAL DIPPING:**

- Aerial dipping should only occur at approved dip sites. Blue River Res. has a use restriction to facilitate dipping. Check with your REAF for approval of dipping sites.
- Be sure to wash buckets when new aerial resources arrive at the fire, when switching dips sites, or when returning to the fire from off forest.

#### WATER DRAFTNG:

- Limited Drafting is available at the bridge across Lookout Creek on the 1506 road in section 28. Check with the REAF for additional drafting locations as needed.
- Utilize fish screens when in fish bearing waterbodies (REAFs have these available).
- Maintain sufficient flow as to not dewater downstream reaches
- Utilize splash pans and absorbent pads. REAFs will assist if given the location.

#### GROUND BASED RETARDANT APPLICATION:

Provide a 75 foot buffer from riparian areas with live water when applying ground based retardant.

#### CHIPPING STANDARDS:

- Provide a 30- foot buffer of no chipping at water crossings or culverts.
- Do not place chips into road ditch.
- Do not chip onto a steep slope where chips will slide back into the ditch.
- Broadcast chipped material, ensuring that chips are no more than 4" deep.

#### HELICOPTER EXTRACTION OPERATIONS

The intent of helicopter insertion/extraction operations is to facilitate the movement of personnel to and from inaccessible areas. These operations are not meant to be a medical transport resource; life flight and ground transportation should always be ordered in addition to the extraction aircraft and crew.

#### ORDERING:

- On-scene EMT and/or Incident within Incident IC determines that an extraction helicopter is needed and places the order through the pre-established procedures:
  - o Division Supervisor
  - o Incident Communications
  - o Dispatch Center
- When ordering extraction aircraft provide the following information:
  - Location (Lat/Long) of patient
  - Known Hazards
  - Wind Speed and Direction
  - o Terrain
  - o Incident Updates

#### SITE SELECTION:

- The helicopter crew will confirm the extraction location when they arrive on scene. However, a general rule is any clearing that is 10'x10' with visible sight lines to the sky is a suitable extraction site.
- If the terrain is steep, excavating a platform or shelf can make it easier for patient packaging.

QR Code-Short-haul Site Selection Video



#### CONSIDERATIONS:

- Short-haul and hoist are safe and efficient operations for extracting injured personnel of any severity including "Green" patients.
- Ensure area is clear of non-essential items, hazards, and personnel.
- Rotor wash may affect overhead hazards and blowing dust/debris can create brown out conditions or influence fire behavior.
- Aerial Supervision is valuable for coordinating aviation medevac/extraction missions and should be ordered if available and not currently present.
- The aircrew will make the final assessment of the mission. Always have a contingency plan in case a helicopter cannot complete the request.

#### **DEFINITIONS:**

Rescue Hoist: A cable winching device mounted to the helicopter that can lower/raise persons attached to a cable.

• Common cable lengths are 250-300 feet.

Short-haul: To insert or extract one or more persons suspended on a fixed line beneath a helicopter.

 Common short-haul line lengths are 100, 150, and 250 feet. The lines can also be connected for a longer line if the situation requires it.

# EMERGENCY PLAN INCIDENT WITHIN AN INCIDENT

### ON SCENE INCIDENT COMMANDER

In the event of an accident or medical incident of any size, your primary responsibility is to ENSURE that the victim(s) receive prompt and effective Triage, Treatment, Extrication and Transport.

- ENSURE THE MEDICAL INCIDENT REPORT IN THE INCIDENT ACTION
  PLAN IS BEING USED AND FOLLOWED- \*IF DETERMINED TO BE A
  GREEN THAT REQUIRES TRANSPORT BACK TO CAMP OR TO A
  MEDICAL FACILITY, DO NOT DECLARE EMERGENCY TRAFFIC AND ONLY
  COMPLETE LINE 1-4 ON MEDICAL INCIDENT REPORT\*.
- Conduct size-up of the incident nature of accident, number type of resources involved, latitude and longitude location (DD°MMM.MM format): notify incident communications center and supervisor, request assistance as needed.
- Order and coordinate medical and support response to the accident.
- Evaluate special needs (law enforcement, haz mat, etc.).
- Clear the command frequency if medical emergency, coordinate with incident communications and air attack for air medical transportation needs.
- Preserve and photograph the scene for accident investigation.
- Remain aware of surroundings and the status of the main incident (delegate personnel to monitor the main fire) to ensure safety of medical treatment personnel.
- Until relieved, supervise and manage all personnel involved at the incident scene.
