#### Fire


Fire activity has been diminished with the cooler and wetter weather. Light to moderate rain fell over the fires yesterday. A stronger, wetter system moves into the region Sunday night into Monday bringing periods of heavy rain and southerly winds. This rain will further tamp down the fires although not extinguish them entirely due to the deep and heavy fuels that are burning.

### **Smoke**

Smoke from the Olympic NP fires is moving to the north down the Elwha River again today towards Port Angeles although concentrations are very light. Smoke amounts are elevated to the West of Port Angeles in the area of the Lower Elwha Reservation. Air quality for the day is expected to be Good on average in Port Angeles although Unhealthy air quality conditions are expected at times near the outflow of the Elwha River to the west of Port Angeles. Recreationists in the area of the Elwha drainage are likely to see and smell smoke at times. The viewpoints of Hurricane Ridge and Deer Park should have Good air quality although views are likely to be impaired by clouds from the incoming weather.
