Comments / notes on tonight's mission and this interpretation:

Tonights imagery was adequate for accurate mapping of the perimeter and major heat sources.

However the 70 meter shift makes it challenging when trying to accurately map the heat sources.

The major fire growth is the 1500 acres expansion on the south side of the eastern most point of the fire.

Numerous spot fires exist on the southern side of this eastern point, surrounding Balman Reservoir and less than a ½ mile from Rainbow lake.

West end of fire it is difficult to see if the heat is all on the east side of the 4wd road, or if it's moved across the road to the west.
