**Comments /notes on tonight's mission and this interpretation:**

Tonights imagery was great for accurate mapping of the perimeter and heat sources.

The fire perimeter expanded slightly on the western side with small amounts of Intense Heat.

The big spot fire on the northeast side expanded north to the road as part of burnout operations.

There are NO NEW spots or isolated heats outside of the perimeter

The rest of the fire shows much reduced heat from last night and is mapped as scattered and isolated heats.
