
Comments /notes on tonight's mission and this interpretation:

Tonights imagery was great for accurate mapping of the perimeter and heat sources.

The heat source highlight tonight is the 55 acre burnout on the eastern end of the fire, dropping down the southeastern ridge of Hunter Peak. On the western end the fire expanded again in the timber, this time only 10 acres.

The big spot fire on the northeast side of the fire only expanded slightly uphill towards the main fire.

The rest of the fire shows reduced heat from last night and is mapped as scattered and isolated heats.
