<b>Comments /notes on tonight's mission and this interpretation:</b> <p>Provided a perimeter made by Colorado Multi Mission Aircraft 7/29 AM to start from. There was active burning during the day. It's size was 767.87 acres.</p> <p>Almost every edge has intense heat. Northeast is more scattered heat and south central. It has crossed into Meade Cabin Historic area.</p> <p>2 spots of isolated heat along Horse Creek in section 12 just east of FR 002, and 2 more spots off far east finger in southwest corner of section 7. Isolated point have a lat/long in the attribute table.</p>
