This fire was previously mapped as the Babaganoush Incident. The primary fire growth this period comes from multiple spot fires growing together in the eastern portion of the fire. Intense heat was mapped in the northeast of the fire area as well as long the fire's northern edge and in a drainage in the southeastern corner of the fire area. The fire remains east of the National Forest Boundary and is still south of the Hot Springs / Park County line.
