Comments /notes on tonight's mission and this interpretation:

Tonights imagery was great for accurate mapping of the perimeter and heat sources.

There is no new perimeter growth, most of the heats are found again in the timbered areas of the burnout in the southwest corner and just east of Cow Camp and were mapped as Scattered Heats.

The rest of the fire shows much reduced heat and is mapped as isolated heats.
