## Comments /notes on tonight's mission and this interpretation:

There was no previous perimeter to start with.

There are two general areas of intensive heat. The larger is on top of what appears to be Green Mountain as Green Mountain Trail crosses it. The other is on the southwest slope of Courthouse Mountain. The Red Creek runs between these, and has one isolated heat source near the creek itself.

There are several small polygons of intense heat outside of these larger areas, as well as quite a few isolated heat sources, mostly on the north and east sides.
