The largest perimeter (Green Mountain) expanded on all sides, but principally on the west and south edges, where areas of intense heat are seen.

The smaller perimeters on Courthouse Mountain expanded slightly, but don't exhibit any intense heat.

There continue to be numerous isolated heat sources and small polygons of intense heat outside the larger areas.
