

Great Basin Team 2 Evacuation Process

Great Basin Team 2 will communicate regularly with the county sheriff and cooperators regarding the fire status and potential for pre-
evacuation/evacuations.

Pre-evacuation notices will be determined by the sheriff in coordination with line operations and liaison officers considering fire status and current and expected fire behavior.

- 1.) The branch director will notify line operations when the fire is threatening and or crossed an evacuation Management Action Point (MAP).
- 2.) Line operations will recommend evacuations for the threatened areas to the communications unit.
- 3.) The communications unit will notify the liaison officers and I.C.
- 4.) The liaison officers will communicate the evacuation recommendation to the appropriate county sheriff.
- 5.) The county sheriff will make the final determination on evacuations and implement those through the county's pre-identified process.

MAP 1: Consider pre-evacuations for the threatened Areas within the Fraser and Winter Park vicinity.

MAP 2: Consider pre-evacuations for threatened structures along Elk Run Road.

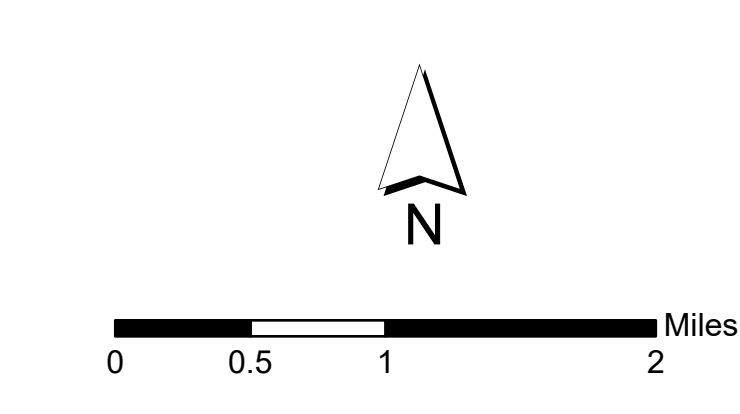
MAP 3: Consider pre-evacuations/evacuations for threatened structures along Elk Run Road.

MAP 4: Consider evacuations for structures in the Aspen Canyon Ranch and Valentine Areas.

MAP 5: Consider evacuations for the Areas (1, 3, 7, 10, 12, 13, 14, 15) that are directly threatened by adjacent fire activity.

MAP 6: Consider closing road access at Jones Pass into Bobtail Creek and ensure public has been evacuated from the area.
