Safety Message

The fire is located in very steep, rugged country, so watch your footing and remember that travel times are much longer than the fire's potential rate of spread. The weather will begin drying today, but an occasional thunderstorm may hit the fire, bringing rain, lightning, and/or gusty winds. Be mindful of snag hazards in Division D. Roads may be dusty and very slick in the same trip!

Country Jam traffic will impact travel near Loma and Mack, so follow the Wild Cow transportation routes to avoid conflicts during the afternoon and evening.





Definitions

- Patient Severity (Stable or Unstable): Equated to urgency and whether situation is "medevac" or "nonemergency" medical transport.
- Medevac: Unstable patient has a life threatening injury or illness. One or more major body systems (respiratory, circulatory, and neurological) are involved.
- Non-Emergency Medical Transport: Stable patient has a non-life threatening injury or illness that
 causes them to be non-ambulatory.
