WEATHER DISCUSSION

Light rain continues in the morning, with some decreases during the afternoon. Southwest winds will be gusty today, with some gusts above 30 mph during the afternoon. Temperatures will be 10 degrees cooler than yesterday, with highs only in the upper 40s. Light rain will return tonight and continue for most of the day Sunday. Temperatures overnight again fall into the middle 30s. Winds Sunday will be lower than today, but will still gust around 20 mph during the day. Temperatures will only reach the low to mid 40s during the afternoon.

Clearing Sunday night will allow temperatures to fall into the low to mid 20s. High pressure builds back in Monday through Wednesday, with temperatures remaining cold through the period. High temperatures will struggle to reach into the 40s, while overnight lows reach the lower 20s, possibly into the upper teens.
