Comments / notes on tonight's mission and this interpretation: I started with the Wildfire Daily Perimeter from NIFS as of 09/24/2023 22:00 MDT. Six isolated heat sources and 3 possible heat sources were detected within the perimeter. There was no perimeter growth. There was no intense or scattered heat mapped. No heat was detected outside the perimeter. All 6 isolated heat sources were found in the eastern half of the fire. The 3 possible heat sources were found in the northeastern corner of the perimeter.
