#### .DISCUSSION...

An upper low pressure system passing by to the south will draw some much needed mid and high level moisture up into the area for both Tuesday and Wednesday. Temperatures both days will be similar to those realized over the weekend and Monday, but an increase in cloud cover is expected along with better overnight RH recovery. Afternoon minimum RH readings should bottom out in the 20 to 25% range.

Plan on lighter downslope winds through the morning, then upslope/up valley flow developing by midday with gusts to 18 mph possible through mid to late afternoon.

Watch out for wildlife and livestock.

**Heavy Equipment:** Dozers, are working on this incident. Don't approach heavy equipment until you are certain they have seen you and signaled for you to continue. **Give them sufficient space on roads and in work areas.**


