3) Consider operational strategies that minimize the impact of smoke-to-smoke sensitive areas and receptors by adjusting tactics, monitoring smoke impacts, and following guidance in state smoke management plans and coordinating with state and local Air Quality Control Commission.										
4) Use appropriate tactics for the fire behavior encountered. Acknowledge, consider and adjust to the transfer of risk where it creates high probabilities of success.
