INCIDENT OBJECTIVES (ICS 202)

1. Incident Name: Creek Fire	2. Operational Period: Date From: 6/14 Time From: 0600	Date To: 6/14 Time To: 2200															
3. Objective(s): 1) Ensure Firefighter and Public Safety 2) Maintain, establish and build relationships with all entities on the fire as well as landowners and public impacted by the fire 2) Utilize appropriate fire strategies to minimize fire suppression impacts on residences, ranch properties, and critical community infrastructure to reduce the potential for adverse health, social, financial, and economic hardships 3) Consider operational strategies that minimize the impact of smoke-to-smoke sensitive areas and receptors by adjusting tactics, monitoring smoke impacts, and following guidance in state smoke management plans and coordinating with state and local Air Quality Control Commission. 4) Use appropriate tactics for the fire behavior encountered. Acknowledge, consider and adjust to the transfer of risk where it creates high probabilities of success.																	
4. Operational Period Command Emphasis: With the highest temperatures being reached since the start of the fire, expect the unexpected. Take considerations of past fire behavior into account and do not overlook quiet areas of the fire that still have potential.																	
General Situational Awareness Fuel moistures combined with hot temperatures and breezy conditions have allowed moderate to high rates of fire spread. With a drying trend continuing, expect spotting potential to increase as the dry breezy conditions continue.
