Demob / Travel – I would love to say Thank You for a good job completed without any major Safety issues... But we are not there yet!

A few things to remember before during and after travel are:

- -Plan your travel: check your routes for weather, clearances and limitations.
- -Double check your load and binding. Equipment should be binded at four points and an additional point for any attachments. Check your load & binding again at 50 miles into your travels.
- -Let someone know your route and estimated times before you leave!
- -No driver is permitted to drive over 10 hours (16hrs with multiple drivers), which includes a 10 minute break every two hours. Be off the road by 2200 hours.
- -Drive defensively: Scan the road ahead and use the "what if" strategy as you observe hazards, know and obey speed limits, maintain a 3 second plus following distance and check your load every time you stop long enough to get out of the vehicle.





FINANCE DEMOB INSTRUCTIONS:

We can accommodate virtual and in-person demobs.

Before your demob date, contact Finance via email (preferred) or phone and make sure that we have all your daily time up to date. If you are a contractor, make sure you have a post inspection completed on your equipment and have your <u>paid in full</u> hotel receipts when you are ready to finalize your paperwork. All contract requirements for lodging shall apply, such as double occupancy, and GSA lodging rate caps. After you demob with finance, you must also scan the QR Code on the cover of the IAP, and scroll to the "Demob Form", or contact Demob directly.

- 6. Note that no equipment or personnel will be released or reassigned without meeting the 2:1 work/rest ratio, unless specifically approved by the Incident Commander. Resources must have the ability to arrive at their home base prior to 2200 hours local time before traveling home. No driver will drive more than 10 hours within any duty day. Multiple drivers in a single vehicle may drive up to the duty-day limitation of 16 hours.
