<p>Upon occurrence of a <b>“MAJOR”</b> medical or accident involving significant injury on the fireline, the closest <b><i>Division Supervisor</i></b> should respond directly to the scene to take control of the situation and direct necessary actions. If DIVS is unavailable, the <b><i>nearest fireline Supervisor or Leader</i></b> needs to take charge.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Clear all radio traffic on incident “Command Channel” – Use to co-ordinate response – do <i>not</i> use names</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Obtain and facilitate nearest EMT’s to the scene, request medical unit response – DIVS in charge of scene.</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Co-ordinate and facilitate appropriate transportation for injured with Medical Unit – EMT in charge of patient(s)</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Nature of Problem    <input type="checkbox"/> # Injured    <input type="checkbox"/> Condition &amp; Vitals    <input type="checkbox"/> Location (GPS coordinates)</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Remove all unnecessary personnel from the accident scene – notify SOFR</li> <li><input type="checkbox"/> Secure the scene area and identify witnesses for later investigation – keep a log</li> </ul> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>Life Safety is the Number 1 Priority on this Incident!</b></p>
