

If a serious medical emergency/accident occurs, notify supervisor, & DIVS, & request the nearest EMT. DIVS will take scene control. Notify Operations of a medical emergency on Command Repeater. Operations will clear all other radio traffic and notify Safety. Advise Operations of nature and extent of injuries, exact location, & nearest drop point or helispot. DIVS or EMT will advise Operations of equipment needs. Safety will coordinate evacuation. If air evacuation is needed, advise immediately of landing area, latitude/longitude and patient weight. **DO NOT GIVE OUT NAMES OVER RADIO.**


