<u>Structure (South and East)</u>: Expect increased fire behavior when structures become involved with fire. Expect encounters with unconventional fuels (i.e., ammunition; noxious smoke from burning plastics and metals; propane gas tanks; creosote-treated utility poles; etc.) Avoid inhaling smoke from these fuels if possible. Space between incoming fire front and structure should be assessed to determine if structure can be safely defended.

AIR OPERATIONS:

Dense smoke from plume will interfere with early morning aircraft use.

SAFETY:

Post lookouts when there is possible danger.

- **Extreme Fire behavior**: LCES at all times. Know what the fire is doing. Maintain situational awareness. Know your escape route as the situation changes and don't allow your escape routes to be cut off. Rapid rates of spread and spotting. What is your contingency? Communicate. Know weather forecast. Clear and concise briefings.
- **Driving**: Drive defensively. Wear seatbelts. All drivers will drive with lights on at all time. Watch out for the other driver. Remain alert for deer crossing roads. Always drive the speed limit. If visibility gets bad due to smoke, maybe you should not b
- **Hazard trees**: Identify, determine mitigation strategy and mitigate by felling or marking with ribbon and stay away. Remember the small ones can get you also.
