

- 6. ON THE DAY FOR YOUR DESIGNATED DEMOB, PLEASE REPORT TO THE DEMOB UNIT IN THE ICP AND PICK UP DEMOB FORM.
- 7. REPORT TO THE DESIGNATED UNITS AS LISTED ON THE DEMOB FORM.
- 8. RETURN TO DEMOB WHEN YOU HAVE COMPLETED CHECKOUT AT ALL UNITS.
- 9. WHEN YOU HAVE BEEN SUCCESSFULLY DEMOBED, THE INCIDENT COMMANDERS AND TEAMS WISH YOU A SAFE TRIP HOME. THANK YOU AND GOOD-BYE.

General: Winds will start out light but build to 10 MPH with Gusts to 15 by the afternoon. RH will dip down AGAIN to near critical levels, so there MIGHT be a red flag warning issued. Continue to watch for the increased chance for REBURN along the lines KBDI and ERC at both the Olustee (just south of fire) and the Eddy (Division A) RAWS station was 713 and ERCs is at 48 yesterday.

Daytime Fires in reburn needles should behave as predicted in the FM 9 until intensity builds. Fires in unburned fuels will build quickly and demonstrate fire behavior best predicted by FM 4.

- > Road conditions continue to be very rough. Driving will require your full concentration. Heavy equipment will be encountered on the forest roads. Reduce your speed and drive courteously.
- Maintain situational awareness. Clear and concise briefings. Communicate. Know weather forecast. What is your contingency? Don't allow your escape routes to be cut off.
- > On nearly every wildfire accident/fatality a communication failure was a major contributor. Keep your use of the radio short and sweet and in plain text. Listen to every transmission—even if it isn't to you—it may affect you. Ensure your crew is kept informed and periodically confirm that they understand too.

STANDARD FIREFIGHTING ORDERS

- 1. Keep informed on fire weather conditions & forecasts
- 2. Know what your fire is doing at all times
- 3. Base all actions on current & expected behavior of the fire
- 4. Identify escape routes & safety zones, and make then known
- 5. Post lookouts when there is possible danger
- 6. Be alert. Keep calm. Think clearly. Act decisively.
- 7. Maintain prompt communications with your forces, your supervisor and adjoining forces.
- 8. Give clear instructions and insure they are understood.
- 9. Maintain control of your forces at all times.
- 10. Fight fire aggressively, having provided for safety first.
