Air Operations:

Morning smog should burn off by 9 AM

Safety:

Heavier fuels and live fuels are still very dry. Watch for intense runs due to gusty winds. Watch for REBURN in all areas.

Major Hazard and Risks:

- > Driving
- The Transition Period is one of the most dangerous periods during a wildfire. As the Florida State Red Team & NIMO Team assumes command of the fire help do your part to ensure everyone is fully informed on tactics, strategy, Escape Routes, Safety Zones and trigger points. Spend a few moments to review the IAP changes with your resources.
- Wind, fire and helicopters can weaken trees. Be wary of trees with weakened root systems. While some snags are flagged, many more snags are not. Anticipate snags especially when operating heavy equipment or felling. Post Lookouts. Mark and avoid snags whenever safely possible. Use your PPE! If thunderstorms approach, expect downdrafts (and lightning) from cells.
- > Driving is major safety concern. Long driving distances, log trucks, sandy and poor roads are just a few of the issues facing everyone each day. Drive defensively, stay alert. *The use of seat belts and headlights are a must!*

Dispersion Range: 0 - 40 = Stable air, lower fire intensity, less long range spotting. Dispersion Range: 41-70 = Moderately unstable air, increased fire intensity and long range spotting. Dispersion Range: 70+ = Unstable air, high amounts of lifting, intense fire activity, potential for significant long range spotting and plume dominated wildfires.

- STANDARD FIREFIGHTING ORDERS
- 1. Keep informed on fire weather conditions & forecasts
- 2. Know what your fire is doing at all times
- 3. Base all actions on current & expected behavior of the fire
- 4. Identify escape routes & safety zones, and make then known
- 5. Post lookouts when there is possible danger
- 6. Be alert. Keep calm. Think clearly. Act decisively.
- 7. Maintain prompt communications with your forces, your supervisor and adjoining forces.
- 8. Give clear instructions and insure they are understood.
- 9. Maintain control of your forces at all times.
- 10. Fight fire aggressively, having provided for safety first.


