WEATHER DISCUSSION:

A weak frontal boundary will slowly approach the region today with light southerly flow over the fire area. The front is expected to stall in the area Wednesday with a slight chance of showers and thunderstorms into Thursday.

 Sky/WeatherAreas of Dense Smoke and Fog in the Morning then partly cloudy. Max Temperature84 to 86 Degrees. Min Humidity40 to 45 Percent. Wind (20 FT)South 2 to 4 MPH in the morning, becoming Southeast 5 to 7 MPH with gusts to around 10 mph in the afternoon. LAL1. Mixing Height300 to 500 FT AGL in the Morning increasing to around 5500 FT AGL. Mixing Winds2 to 3 in the Morning increasing to around 45. LVORI

Sky/WeatherBecoming Mostly Cloudy. Areas of Dense Smoke and Fog in the Morning. Min Temperature58 to 60 Degrees. Max Humidity95 to 100 Percent. Wind (20 FT)South 4 to 6 MPH with gusts around 10 MPH until midnight then South 2 to 3 MPH. LAL1. Mixing Height
.Wednesday
 Sky/WeatherAreas of Dense Smoke and Fog in the Morning then cloudy with a 20% chance of showers and thunderstorms. Max Temperature82 to 84 Degrees. Min Humidity44 to 48 Percent. Wind (20 FT)South 3 to 5 MPH early in the morning becoming Southwest 4 to 6 MPH with gusts to around 10 mph by the afternoon. LAL1. Mixing Height200 to 500 FT AGL increasing to around 5000 FT AGL. Mixing WindsSouthwest around 10 MPH. Dispersion IndexAround 40.
