MAP 8-
Condition- Fire crosses FS Road 46 to the North.
Actions- If fire crosses MAP, suppression strategies will be used to safely minimize fire spread to the North.

MAP 13-
Condition- Fire approaches or threatens to cross FR50.
Actions- Take appropriate action to suppress fire.

MAP 7-
Condition- Fire approaches the western wilderness boundary on FR33. Potential to impact or cross.
Actions- Take appropriate actions applicable to fire conditions, behavior and determined boundary locations.

MAP 9-
Condition- Fire crosses or threatens the MAP along NFS Road 40-15.7.
Actions- Suppression strategies will be used to safely minimize fire spread to the West.

MAP 2-
Condition- Fire has crossed or threatened to cross MAP 2 and current and expected fire behavior indicates that the fire could impact Sweetwater Cabin rec site.
Actions- Consider improving existing control lines. Consider installation of hose lay and sprinklers around Sweetwater Cabin. If occupied, consider evacuation of Sweetwater Cabin occupants.

MAP 3-
Condition- Fire has crossed or threatened to cross MAP 3 and current and expected fire behavior indicates that the fire could impact. Transitions into continuous fuels all the way down to Juniper Springs Rec. Site.
Actions- Consider improving existing control lines to the North of Juniper Springs Campground. Consider prep-work around infrastructure in Juniper Springs Campground. Potentially vacate day use area in Camp Ground.

MAP 1v2-
Condition- Fire has crossed or threatened to cross MAP 1v2 and current and expected fire behavior indicates that the fire could impact SR 19 and values at risk east of SR19. Potential smoke impact of SR 19 and other values at risk east of SR 19.
Actions- Consider start prep work along SR 19 to keep fire west of SR 19. Consider burn out operations to keep fire west of SR 19 utilizing aerial and/or hand ignitions. Contact FLDOT and Marion County Sheriff's Office and FHP. Post electronic signs to warn public of potential smoke impact. Consider air resources to slow fire progression or pretreat fuels.
