Weather & Fire Behavior:

Are you prepared for predicted fire behavior as forecasted?

Are you prepared for the possibility of more severe weather and fire behavior? Transportation:

There are long drive times for visiting resources to/from hotels. Take your time.

Drive safely & defensively.

Cell phone use is not allowed while driving.

Heat Related Illness:

Pace yourself as you work in the heat of the day.

Take frequent breaks in a cooler area if possible.

Drink plenty of water both during your shift and off, regardless of outside temps. Fatigue:

How many days have you been here on this assignment?

Fatigue has a cumulative effect. Get sufficient rest during down time.

Medical Emergencies:

Are you prepared to deal with a medical emergency?

Do you understand incident medical emergency procedures?

It may be a long way to medical facilities.
