

WEATHER DISCUSSION:

Critical fire weather conditions may develop this afternoon due to strong wind speeds. A dry front is forecast to move across the incident area this afternoon. As a result, the winds will increase with gusts of 20 to 25 mph. Similar conditions are expected again Thursday due to strong onshore winds from the Atlantic Ocean.

The main concern: Strong wind gusts.

WEATHER FORECAST WEDNESDAY:

WEATHER: Partly cloudy and breezy.
MAX TEMPERATURES: Around 85. (24 hour trend = down 3)
MIN HUMIDITY: 35 to 40 percent (24 hour trend = up 10 percent)
20 FT WINDS: Northeast 5 to 10 mph in the morning...becoming east and increasing to 12 to 18 mph during the afternoon with gusts to 25 mph.
STABILITY/INVERSION: Mixing heights around 6000 ft in the afternoon.
Dispersion Index 77. Haines Index 4.
TRANSPORT WINDS: East 26 mph.

WEATHER: Partly cloudy. Mild.
MIN TEMPERATURES: Low around 60. (24 hour trend = unchanged)

STABILITY/INVERSION: Inversion to 600 feet. Dispersion Index 8.

OUTLOOK FOR THURSDAY: Partly Cloudy. Continued breezy. Northeast 5 to 10 mph in the morning...becoming east 10 to 15 mph with gusts to 22 mph in the afternoon. High 82 to 85. Minimum humidity 36 to 42 percent.

Fire Behavior Forecast

Weather Summary (See Detailed Weather Forecast in the IAP):

Partly cloudy and breezy today with temperatures reaching the mid 80's. Minimum RH will range from 35-40%. East winds will range from 12-18mph sustained in the afternoon. A Haines index of 4 and a dispersion index of 77 are forecast.

General Fire Behavior: Once again critical fire weather is predicted for today. Even though the RH will increase today the increase in winds will overcome the RH and cause very active fire behavior today. Expect moderate fire behavior after the morning inversion breaks around 0930. Fire behavior will increase to active by 1100 and very active during the peak hours 1600 through 2000 hrs. There is a potential for extreme fire behavior from 1800 to 1900 hours. During peak hours swamp shrub and swamp bay fuels will burn intensely on the surface producing 8 to 15 foot lengths and spread rates of 10 to 12 chains per hour. Brisk east winds will facilitate torching and short range spotting out to 100 yards. The swamp fuels will produce moderate backing spread rates of 2-4 chains per hour. During peak burning hours, pine fuels will spread at 60-80 chains/hr with very high intensities in the palmetto/gallberry rough (15-30ft flame lengths). Single tree and group torching in open canopy pine can produce spotting out to 300 yards. Young, closed canopy pine plantations (5-10yrs) have the potential to support sustained crown fire. Probability of ignition will be 90% during the peak burning period.

Specific Fire Behavior:

Branch I: The increase in winds will cause more needle cast. Rekindle in needle cast will continue to occur in the burned area from DIV H to DIV F. Needle cast has filled in containment lines providing an escape path to green fuels for any reburn occurring near containment lines. Low to moderate intensity burnout along portions of the swamp edge break from DIV D to the branch break has created a high potential for reburn.

Branch II: The burn out from yesterday has advanced the fire edge toward the swamp edge break in DIV G and H. The fire edge will continue to back to the East. Backing spread during peak hours in the swamp shrub will range from 2-4 chains per hour moving near 1/3 mile per day.

Air Operations: Inversions will persist until 0900. Expect heavy smoke production from interior burning from 1300 to 2000 hrs.

Safety: Be alert to indicators of extreme fire behavior:

- Tree crowning out inside fireline
- Smoldering fires beginning to burn actively
- Approaching thunderheads with dark clouds beneath
- Presence of dust devils and whirlwinds
- Increased spotting
- Sudden calm
- High clouds moving fast in direction different from surface wind



Medical emergencies will be reported to the Division Supervisor. The Division Supervisor will assume command and call for the closest line medic, and resources in the division that are EMT qualified. The Division Supervisor will notify communications by radio or cell phone. (Big Turnaround ICP 912-496-2111)

Communications to notify MEDL @ 904-955-0022.

The report should include type of illness/injury and exact loaction of the incident. Communications will clear the air for emergency traffic only and will request key personnel to report to communications. If an air medical helicopter is used within the fire perimeter, communications should notify the air operations director and helibase.

INCIDENT EMERGENCY PLAN (IEP)

The goal of this Incident Emergency Plan (IEP) is to provide the guidelines necessary to Locate, Triage, Extricate, Treat and Transport accident Patients. The Division/Group Supervisor will initially oversee the emergency. Radio communication will be on the "Command Frequency". Names of injured or deceased individuals should not be given over the radio. Deceased individuals and their equipment are not to be moved, except to accomplish rescue work or to protect the health and safety of others. It is expected this organization will come from resources assigned within the Division or nearest adjoining forces.

DIVISION/GROUP SUPERVISOR

- Conduct Size-up of the Incident (Nature of Accident, Number/Type of Resources, Location)
- □ Coordinate "Line EMT" response to the accident (Utilize Closest EMT's).
- □ Begin "TRIAGE"
- Determine and initiate treatment and transportation needs
- □ Evaluate special needs (Law Enforcement, Heavy Rescue, Haz Mat)
- Coordinate with Air Attack for Air-Medical transportation needs
- □ Preserve the scene for accident investigation

MEDICAL GROUP SUPERVISOR (This position will be filled, only if needed)

- □ Supervise TRIAGE, Treatment and Transportation Unit Leaders.
- Delace orders through Communications for ground ambulance, medical personnel, as needed
- □ Ensure proper security and traffic control.

TRIAGE UNIT LEADER (This position will be filled, only if needed)


- □ Locate and TRIAGE all patients and relays information to Medical Group Supervisor.
- □ Ensure that Airway, Breathing and Circulation stabilization of patients is addressed during TRIAGE.
- Coordinate with Treatment Unit Leader for patient stabilization, extrication, and movement to treatment area.
- □ Utilize the "START" TRIAGE system.

TREATMENT UNIT LEADER (This position will be filled, only if needed)

- Establishes Immediate, Delayed and Minor treatment areas.
- Direct treatment and stabilization of Patients.
- □ Prioritize Patients for transport.
- □ Request medical personnel and supplies, as needed.
- Ensure continual TRIAGE of patients in treatment area.
- Coordinate with TRIAGE Unit leader for delivery of patients to the treatment area.
- Coordinate with the Transportation Unit Leader for delivery of patients to ambulances.
- Ensure documentation of patient conditions and treatments on TRIAGE tags.

TRANSPORTATION UNIT LEADER (This position will be filled, only if needed)

- Coordinate all patient transportation to medical facilities, air and ground.
- Establish communication with hospitals receiving patients.
- □ Coordinate with Treatment Unit Leader to determine number and category of patients.
- Designate ambulance/helicopter loading areas.
- Determine mode (air/ground) of patient transportation.
- Ensure patients information and destination is recorded.
