**WEATHER DISCUSSION:** A northeast wind surge will move into the area later today. Gusty conditions will develop along with cooler temperatures tonight and Monday.

The **main concern is:**

1. Gusty winds northeast developing with drying conditions in the afternoon.

### **WEATHER FORECAST DAY SHIFT Sunday:**

**WEATHER:** . A 30 percent chance of morning showers. Becoming breezy with clearing in the afternoon.

**MAX TEMPERATURES:** 81-84 (24 hour trend = 4 deg lower)

**MIN HUMIDITY:** 44-48% (24 hour trend ~10% higher)

**20 FT WINDS:** North 7 to 12 mph becoming Northeast 12 to 18 mph gusts to 23 mph late afternoon.

**STABILITY/INVERSION:** No morning inversion. Mixing heights around 5000 ft. Dispersion Index around 50. Haines 3-4.

### **WEATHER FORECAST NIGHT SHIFT Sunday night:**

**WEATHER:** Clearing and cooler. Breezy well into the evening.

**MIN TEMPERATURES:** 53-57.

**MAX HUMIDITY:** Recovery 60 percent near the fire and near 75 percent elsewhere.

**20 FT WINDS:** Northeast 15 to 20 mph and gusty in the evening decreasing to 10 to 15 mph after midnight.

**STABILITY/INVERSION:** No inversion. Smoke dispersion 15 to 25. Mixing heights near 1200 ft.

**OUTLOOK FOR MONDAY:** Partly cloudy...breezy and dry. High temperatures around 76. Minimum RH values 27 to 33 %. Northeast winds 12 to 17 mph with gusts to 23 mph in the afternoon.

**EXTENDED...TUESDAY THROUGH FRIDAY:** A low pressure system off the South Carolina coast will drift slowly in place while keeping a northeast wind over the region. **\*Traffic:** Turn on headlights to be seen in smoke, haze. Smoke has been a problem most mornings. Wear seat belts. Bridge is out in DIV EB on Race Pond Road west of US 1 just past the communication tower. Take another route. The State Championship trap shoot competition is located in DIV EF and will end Sunday. Expect traffic to be heavy as these people leave.

**\*Critters:** Keep an eye out for **snakes, bees, and gators**. There are at least three types of rattlesnakes in the swamp area, plus Cottonmouths and Coral snakes --- all poisonous. Also, there are commercial beehives in the area. Most of these have electric fences around the colonies, but could be a real hazard if they are not seen and steered clear of. Alligators should not to be agitated. In the Refuge, all wildlife is protected.
