**WEATHER DISCUSSION:** A strong pressure gradient between a high pressure ridge over the eastern U.S. and a low pressure system off the South Carolina coast will maintain a breezy northeast flow over the entire refuge Monday through Tuesday.

The **main concern is:**

1. A **Red Flag Warning** is in effect for today.
2. A gusty northeast wind with drying conditions in the afternoon.

**WEATHER FORECAST DAY SHIFT Monday:**

**WEATHER:** Sunny...breezy and dry.

**MAX TEMPERATURES:** 73-76 (24 hour trend = 8 deg lower)

**MIN HUMIDITY:** 25-30 percent (24 hour trend ~ 18 percent lower)

**20 FT WINDS:** Northeast at 13 to 18 mph with gusts to 25 mph.

**STABILITY/INVERSION:** Shallow morning inversion around 1000 ft lifting to around 4000 ft by noon. Mixing heights around 4500 ft in the afternoon. Dispersion Index around 62. Haines 4.

**WEATHER FORECAST NIGHT SHIFT Monday night:**

**WEATHER:** Clear and cooler. Breezy well into the evening.

**MIN TEMPERATURES:** 48-51. (24 hour trend = 5 deg lower)

**MAX HUMIDITY:** Recovery to 50 percent near the fire and near 70 percent elsewhere.

**20 FT WINDS:** Northeast at 12 to 17 mph and gusty in the evening decreasing to 10 to 15 mph after midnight.

**STABILITY/INVERSION:** Shallow inversion setting up around 600 ft. Smoke dispersion 12. Mixing heights near 650 ft.

Post lookouts if you have to work in these areas and identify suspect trees so they can be removed or avoided.

\* **Situational Awareness:** Keep a head's up for changes and fire behavior. With the extreme conditions and fire behavior exhibited by this fire since it began, nothing can be taken for granted. The small amounts of rain will not make much difference in fire behavior.

\* **Burnouts:** As burnouts are conducted, make sure all resources involved are briefed and that all adjoining resources are notified of the operation. Cover your escape routes so they are not clogged by volunteers if you need to move quickly. A good thing would be to stage them as they come up, and only send in them in as needed.
