- \* **Traffic:** When you are stopping on the roads in the fire area, make sure you pull over enough for other traffic to get by. Drive cautiously when approaching these areas and be heads up for personnel in the area. Watch your speed, drive with lights on and seatbelts fastened.
- \* Night Operations: Make sure you have fresh batteries for headlamps. Check the areas that you are working for powerlines and structures. Know where everyone is before moving equipment or vehicles. Get a good briefing from day operations.
- \* Work/Rest: Make sure you adhere to the 2:1 work/rest ratio. Several shifts have had to extend hours of operations. Supervisors must ensure that work/rest guidelines are followed.

The Division Supervisor will notify communications by radio or cell phone. (Big Turnaround ICP 912-496-2111)

The report should include type of illness/injury and exact loaction of the incident. Communications will clear the air for emergency traffic only and will request key personnel to report to communications. If an air medical helicopter is used within the fire perimeter, communications should notify the air operations director and helibase.
