Contain the fire to the area north of SR 2; east of Swamp Road in Ware County; south and west of US Hwy 1 and the CSX Railroad line; and within the Perimeter Road, monitoring fire advance within the swamp interior in Okefenokee National Wildlife Refuge.</li> <li>4. **WEATHER DISCUSSION:** Subtropical Depression Andrea off the Georgia and Northeast Florida coast will continue to drift slowly south to southeast through Saturday.

The main concern is:

1. Decreasing relative humidity with warmer temperatures on Friday and Saturday.

**WEATHER FORECAST DAY SHIFT Friday:**

**WEATHER:** Becoming Partly Cloudy.

**MAX TEMPERATURES:** 86-89 (24 hour trend = 7 deg higher)

**MIN HUMIDITY:** 32-37 percent (24 hour trend ~ 12 percent lower)

**20 FT WINDS:** Northeast at 10 to 15 mph with gusts to 20 mph.

**STABILITY/INVERSION:** Inversion setting up to 1000 feet dissipating by 0800. Mixing heights around 4800 ft in the afternoon. Dispersion Index around 48. Haines Index 2 (very low).

**WEATHER:** Mostly Clear.

**MIN TEMPERATURES:** 63-66. (24 hour trend = No change)

**MAX HUMIDITY:** Recovery to 70 percent near the fire and around 90 percent elsewhere.

**STABILITY/INVERSION:** Inversion setting up to 1000 ft dissipating by 0800. Dispersion Index around 4.

Medical emergencies will be reported to the Division Supervisor. The Division Supervisor will assume command and call for the closest line EMT, or resources in the division that are EMT qualified. The Division Supervisor will notify communications by radio or cell phone. (Big Turnaround ICP 912-496-2111)

The report should include type of illness/injury and exact location of the incident. Communications will clear the air for emergency traffic only and will request key personnel to report to communications. If an air medical helicopter is used within the fire perimeter, communications should notify the air operations director and helibase.
