

SPECIFIC FIRE BEHAVIOR:

All Divisions: Again... increased winds will override slightly cooler temps and higher humidities. Rates of spread anticipated for heaviest fuels in a heading fire will more likely be approached today than yesterday. Crown torching levels will be almost continuous both in the swamp and on the hill. More northerly winds will test lines and line deepening in both SE and SW quadrants.

Structure: Okefenokee administrative site may be impacted by fire spread during this operational period...

IA: Expect moderate to extreme fire behavior with fires establishing quickly during the day.

AIR OPERATIONS: Inversion breaking near 1000 this morning. SAFETY: What is your travel speed? Predicted ERC for today is 33.

<u>WEATHER DISCUSSION</u>: A cold front is expected to move through the complex Sunday. This will create a chance of showers and thunderstorms.

The main concern is:

1. Increasing wind speeds with afternoon gusts 20 to 25 mph. Erratic and gusty winds in the the vicinity of showers and thunderstorms.

WEATHER FORECAST DAY SHIFT Sunday:

WEATHER: Becoming Mostly Cloudy with a 40% chance of an thunderstorm.
MAX TEMPERATURES: 85 (24 hour trend = 5 deg lower)
MIN HUMIDITY: 35-40 percent (24 hour trend ~ 3 to 5 percent higher)
20 FT WINDS: North to Northeast 10 to 15 mph with gusts around 20 mph.
STABILITY/INVERSION: Mixing heights around 6000 ft in the afternoon. Dispersion Index around 16.
Haines Index 2 (very low).

WEATHER FORECAST NIGHT SHIFT Sunday night:

WEATHER: Mostly cloudy with a 40 percent chance of evening showers with a possible thunderstorm decreasing to 20 percent chance of showers overnight.

MIN TEMPERATURES: 65. (24 hour trend = No change)

MAX HUMIDITY: Recovery to 75 percent near the fire and around 95 percent elsewhere.

20 FT WINDS: Northeast 3-5 mph.

STABILITY/INVERSION: Inversion setting up to 500 ft dissipating by 0800. Dispersion Index around 5.

<u>OUTLOOK FOR</u> Monday: A few morning showers then becoming partly cloudy. Winds northeast 8 to 12 mph becoming east 15 mph with gusts to 25 mph. High temperature around 82. Minimum rh 35 to 40 percent.

*** Weather:** All of us got a wake up call with the heavy fog/smoke yesterday morning. We have had it already on this incident, but not to the denseness that it was yesterday. There is also a chance of thunderstorms in the forecast. Be heads up for the development of thunderheads and take time to review the **Thunderstorm Safety** section in your IRPG, page 75. If you don't have an IRPG, see SAFETY to get one.

* **Critters:** Snakes, alligators, ticks, chiggers, black flies, etc. Use protective sprays and watch where you step. **Don't** feed the alligators under any circumstances.

***Traffic:** We have discussed traffic and driving many times on this incident. As we continue to log many miles on the roads, we will keep hitting on this subject. If weather causes problems on the roads, such as the fog/smoke yesterday, slow your speed to match the conditions. It is better to be a few minutes late than to put yourself or anyone else at risk with recklessness or speeding. WATCH YOUR SPEED AND DRIVE WITH YOUR SEATBELTS FASTENED AND LIGHTS ON!

The Division Supervisor will notify communications by radio or cell phone. (Big Turnaround ICP 912-496-2111)

The report should include type of illness/injury and exact loaction of the incident. Communications will clear the air for emergency traffic only and will request key personnel to report to communications. If an air medical helicopter is used within the fire perimeter, communications should notify the air operations director and helibase
