High pressure will build over the complex area Monday.

The main concern is: East northeast winds around 10 to 15 mph in the morning becoming east and increasing to 15 mph with gusts to 25 mph possible.

### WEATHER FORECAST DAY SHIFT Monday:

**WEATHER:** Partly cloudy.

**MAX TEMPERATURES:** 84 (24 hour trend = 5 degrees lower )

**MIN HUMIDITY:** Around 35 to 40 percent (24 hour trend = little change)

**20 FT WINDS:** East northeast 10 to 15 mph early becoming east in the afternoon and increasing to 15 mph with gusts to 25 mph possible.

**STABILITY/INVERSION:** Mixing heights around 5400 ft in the afternoon. Dispersion Index 55. Haines Index 5 (moderate).

The report should include type of illness/injury and exact location of the incident. Communications will clear the air for emergency traffic only and will request key personnel to report to communications. If an air medical helicopter is used within the fire perimeter, communications should notify the air operations director and helibase.
